Project Vote and is national nonprofit, nonpartisan organization that provides a range of sophisticated civic engagement services to state and local organizations. Our organization bring together experienced organizers, attorneys, and academics to provide partners with the additional skills, capacity, and relationships they need to plan and manage cost-effective voter contact programs. Our services scale up from a neighborhood of just a few precincts to a national program operating simultaneously in dozens of cities, and from a staff 10 to a staff of 10,000.

Voter Registration Program Services
