

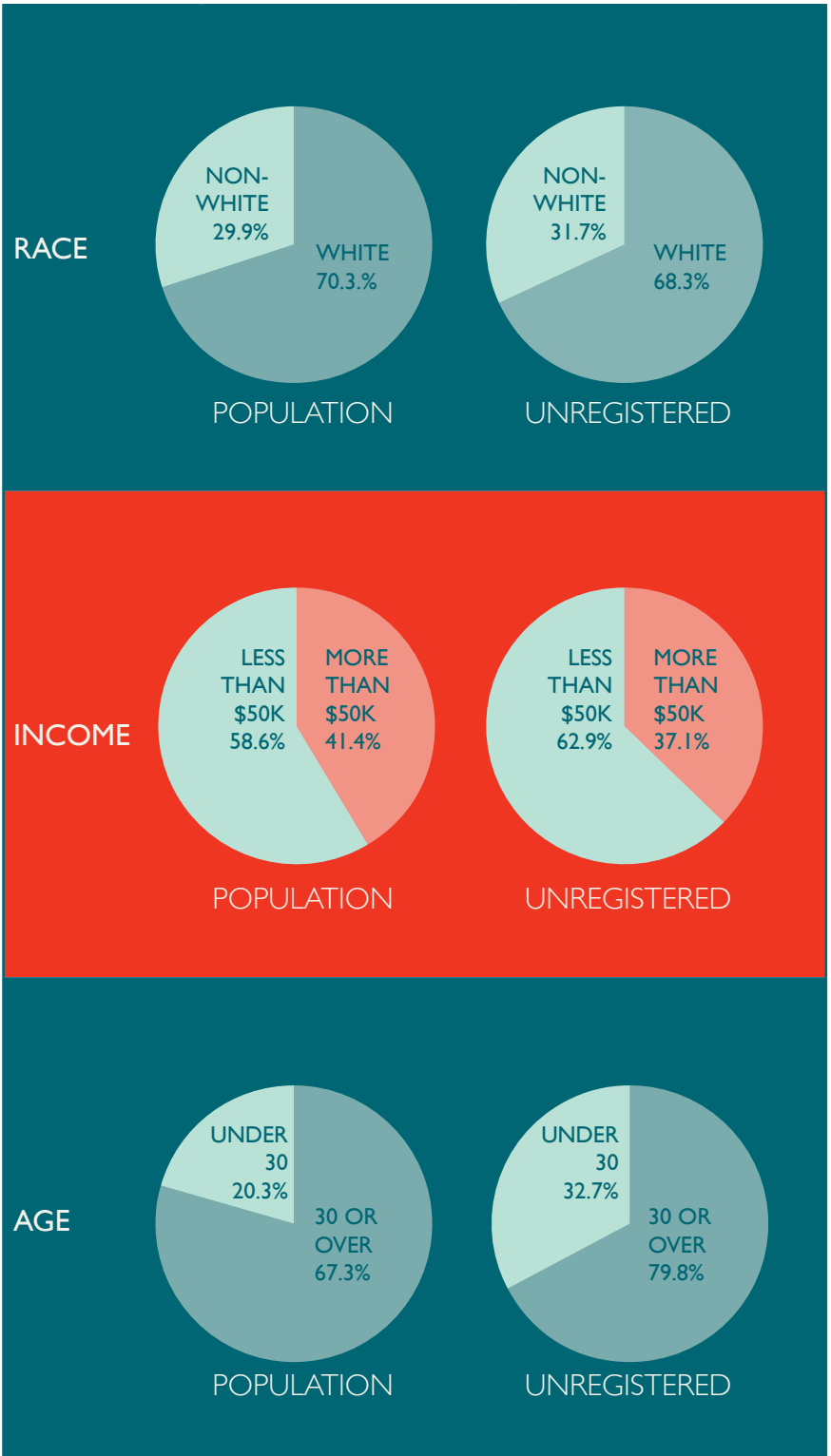

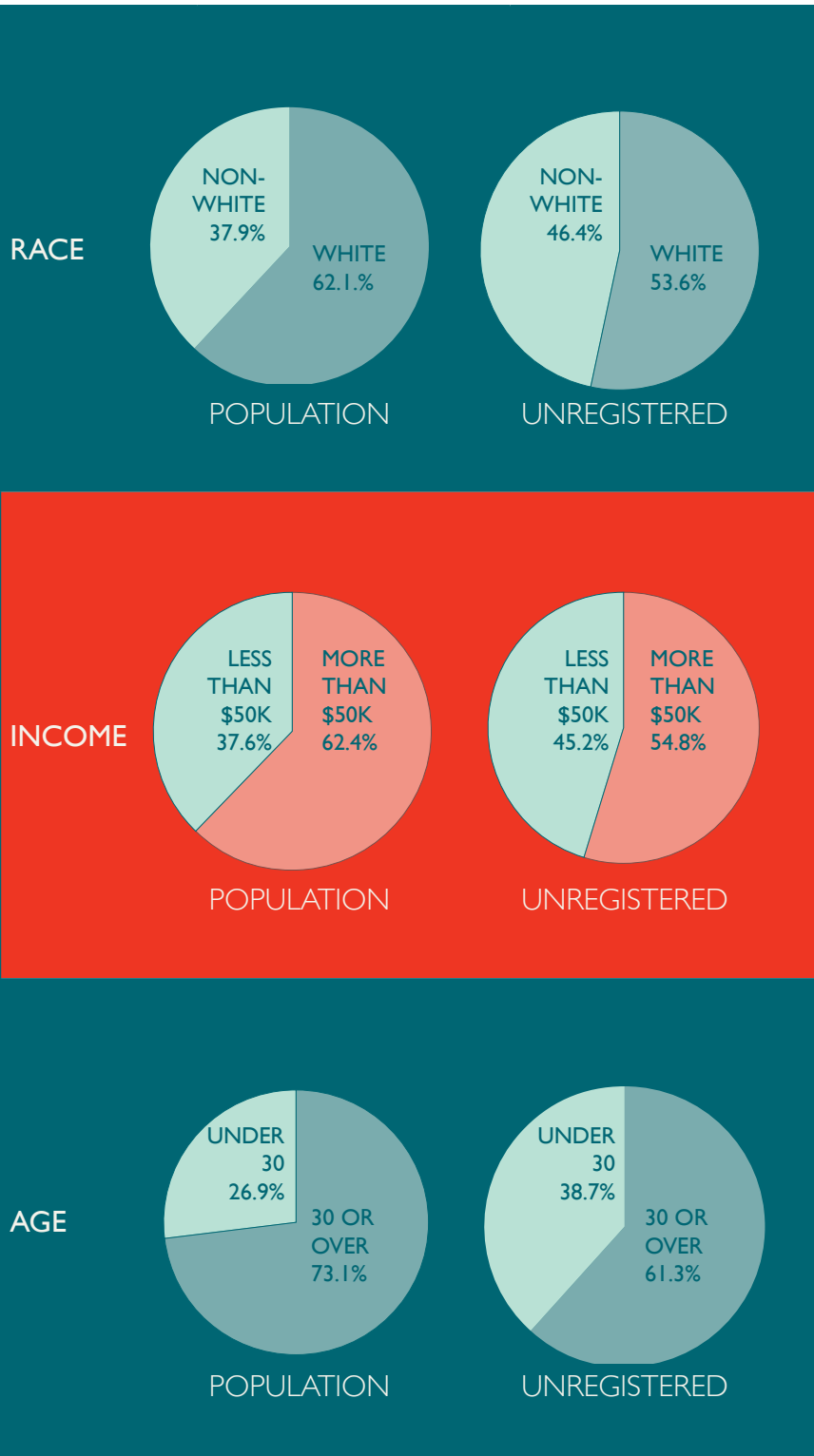

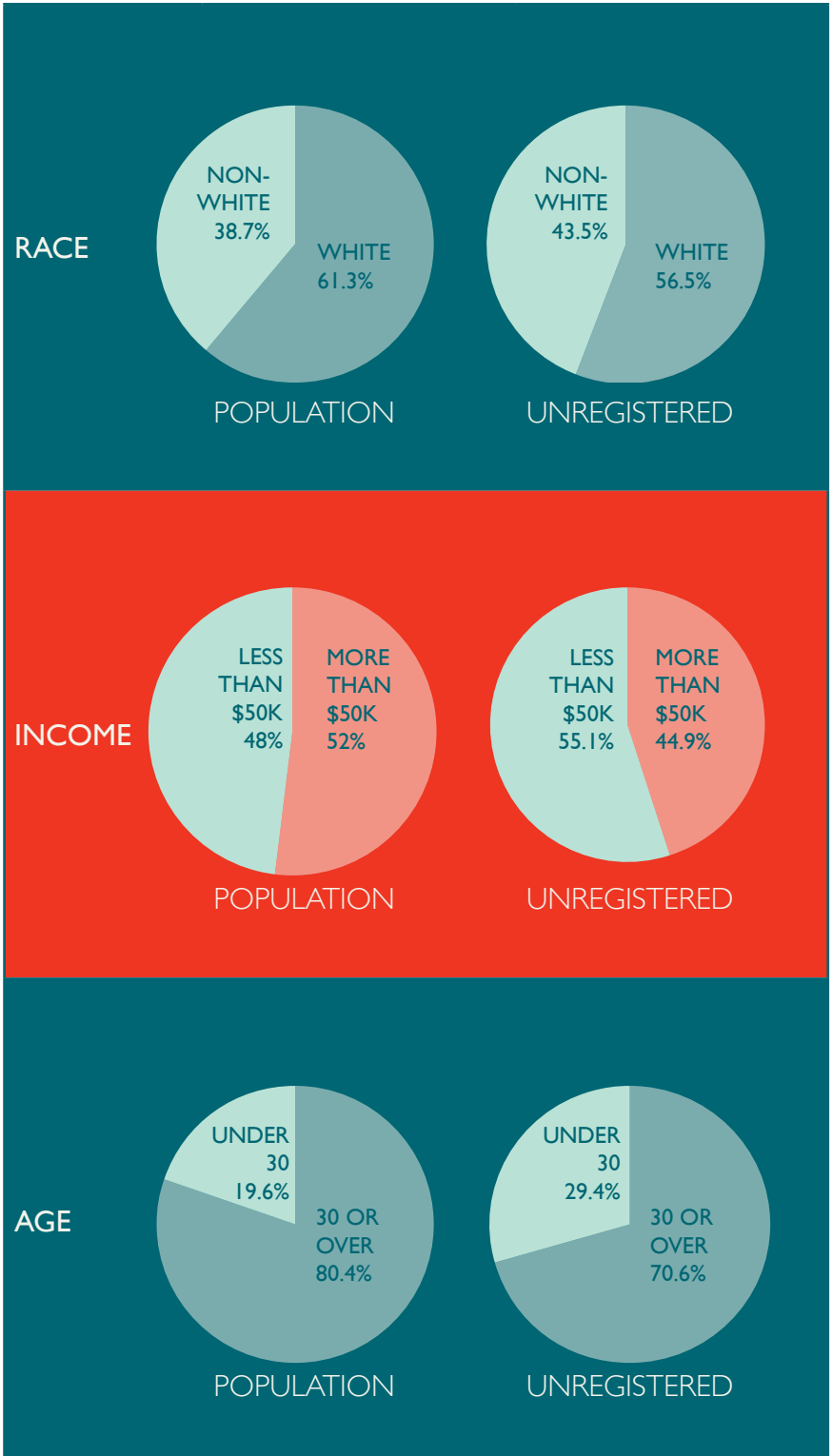

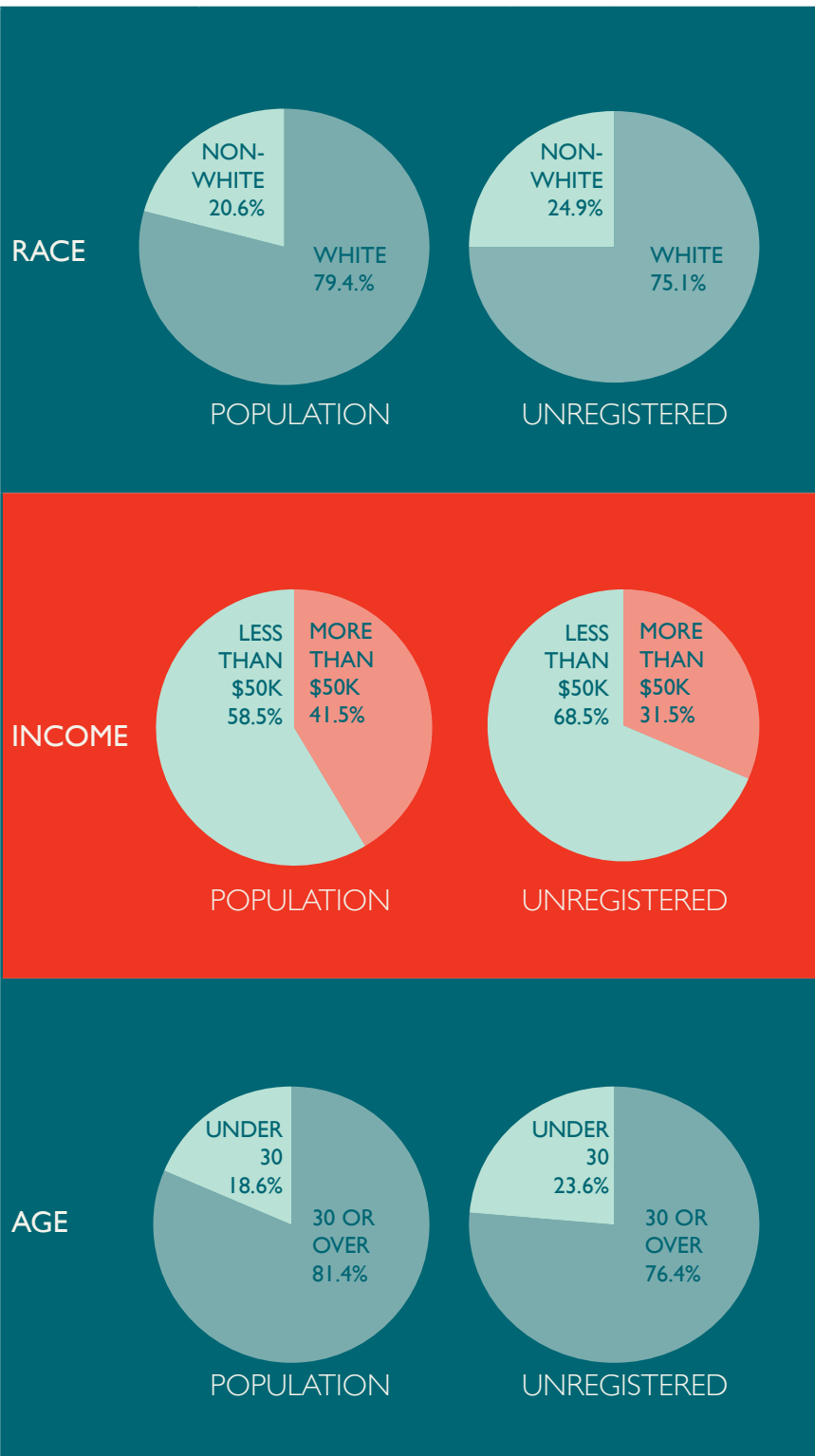

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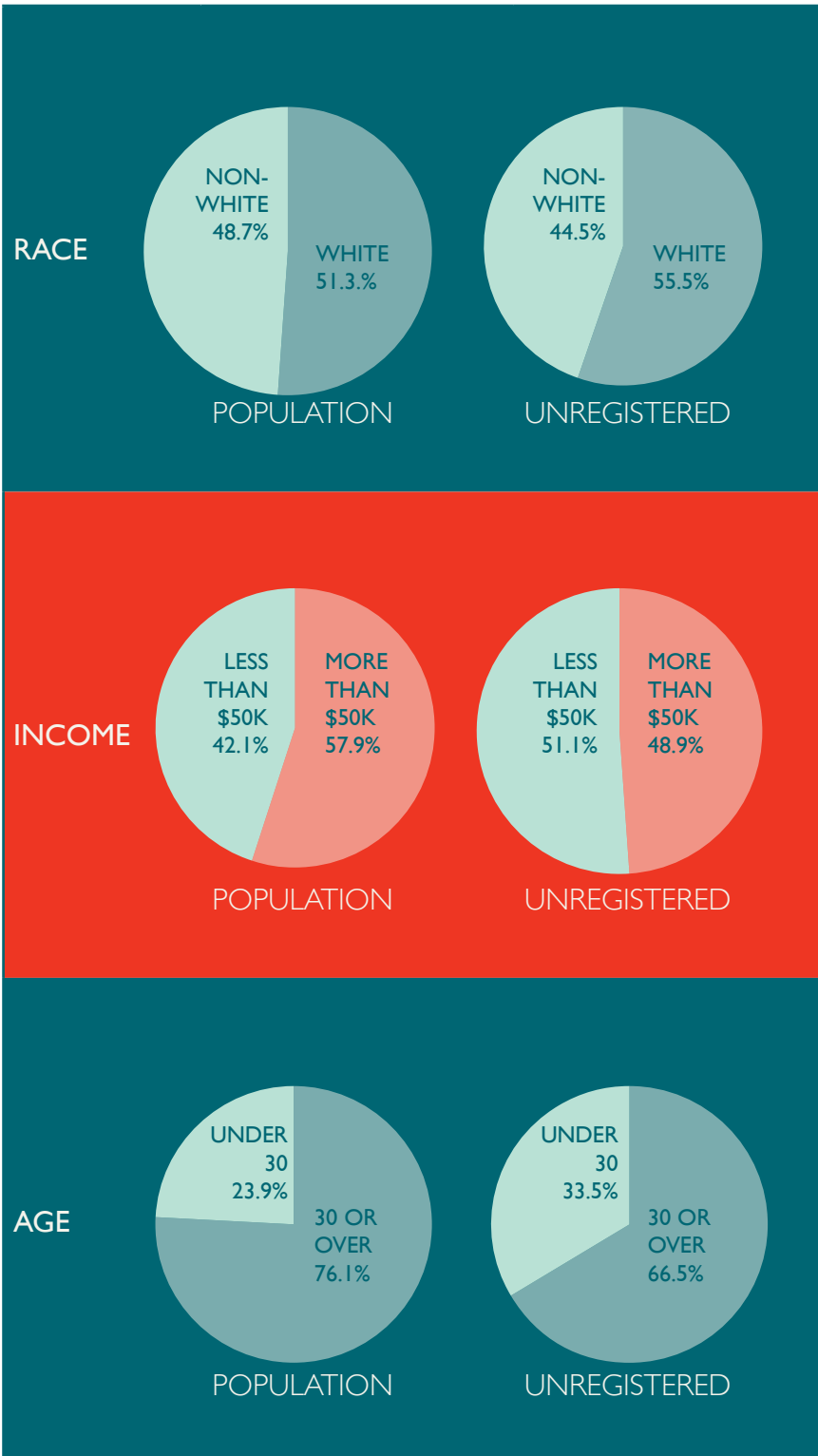

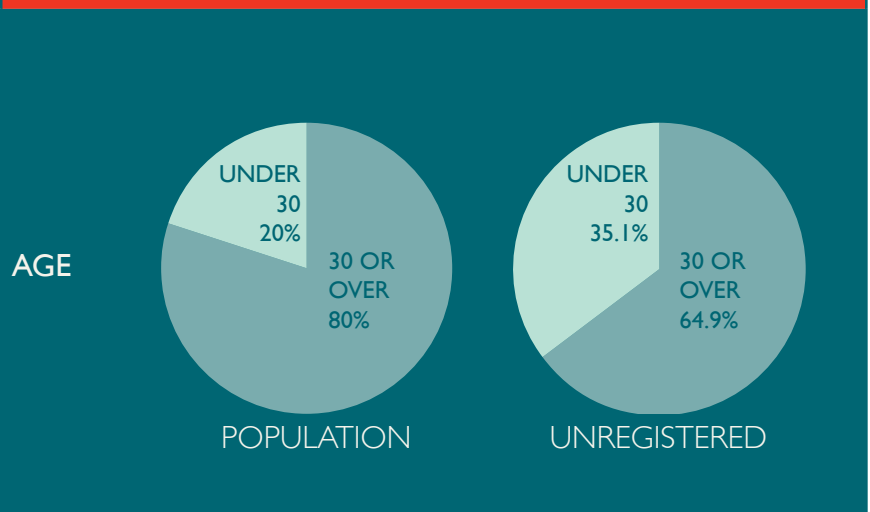

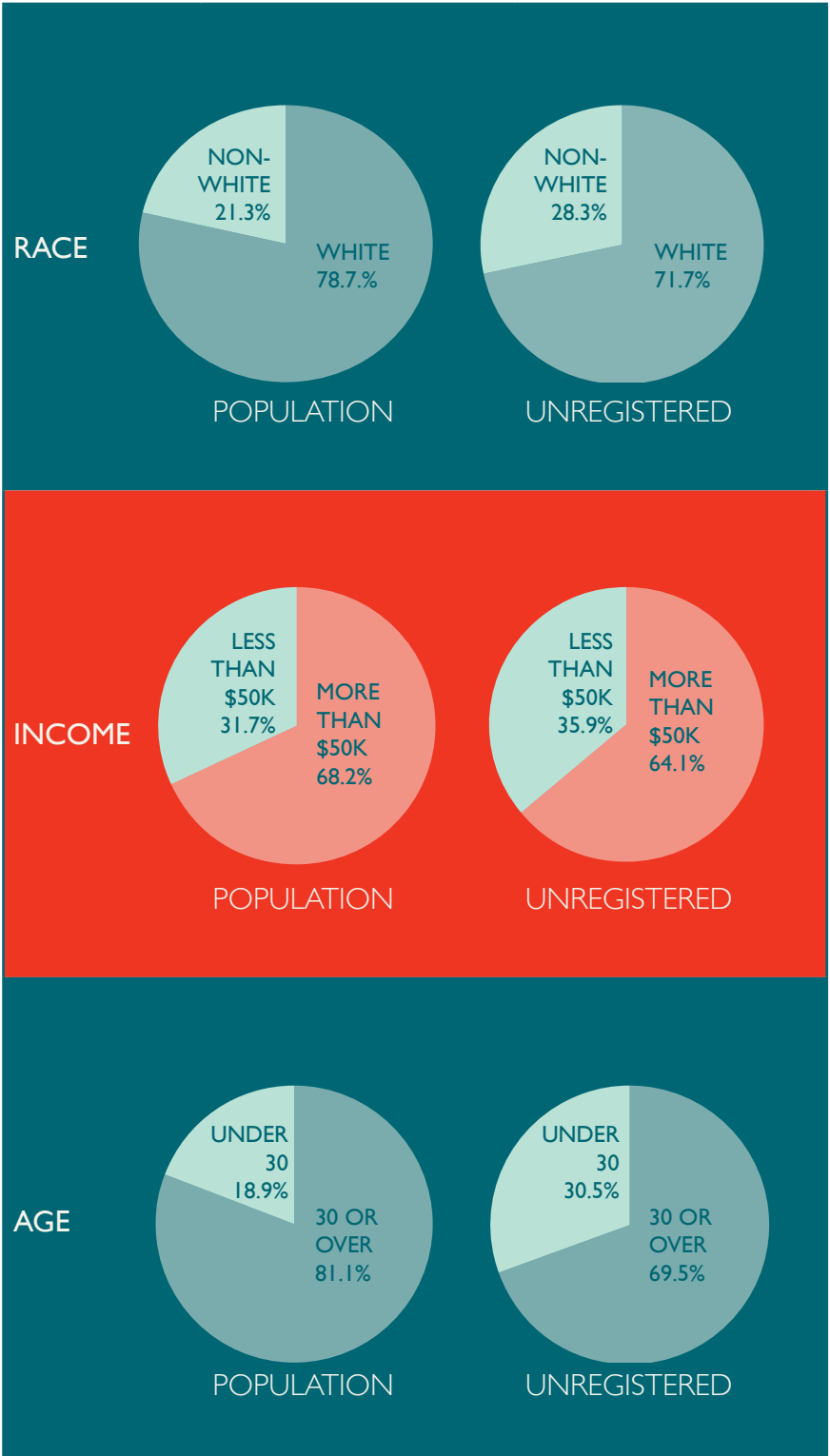

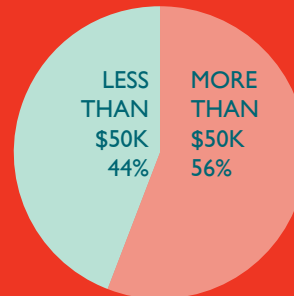

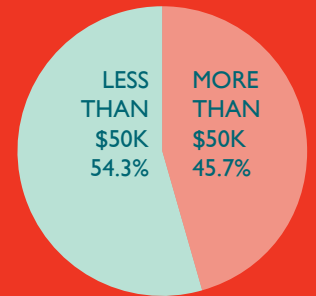

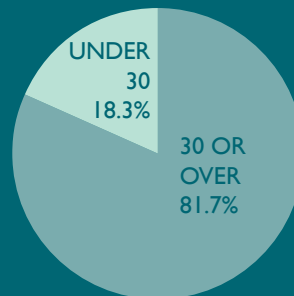

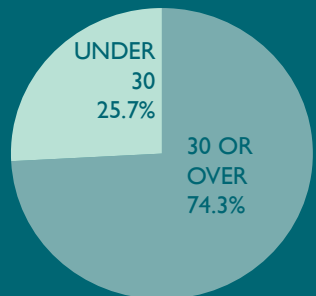

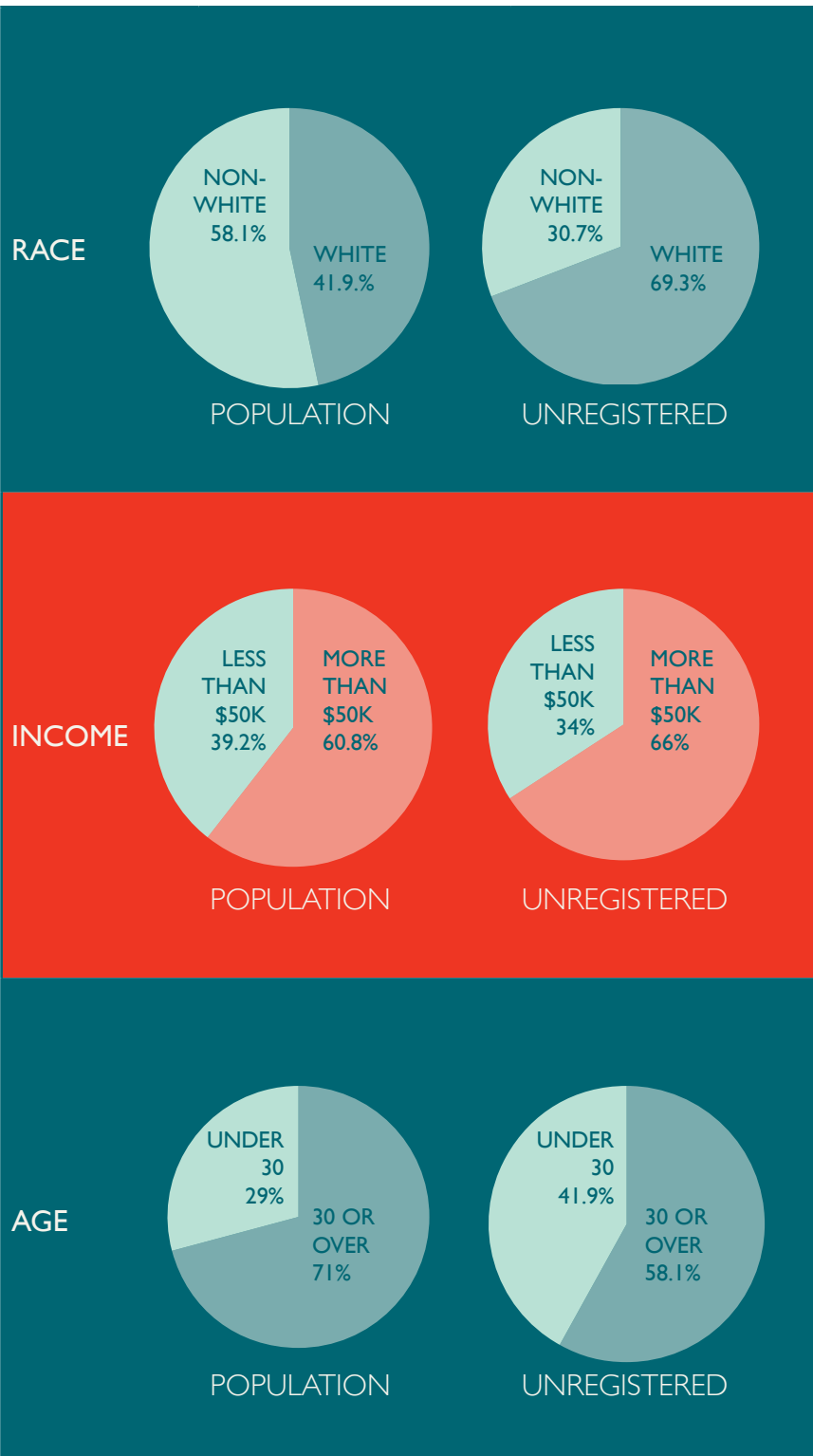

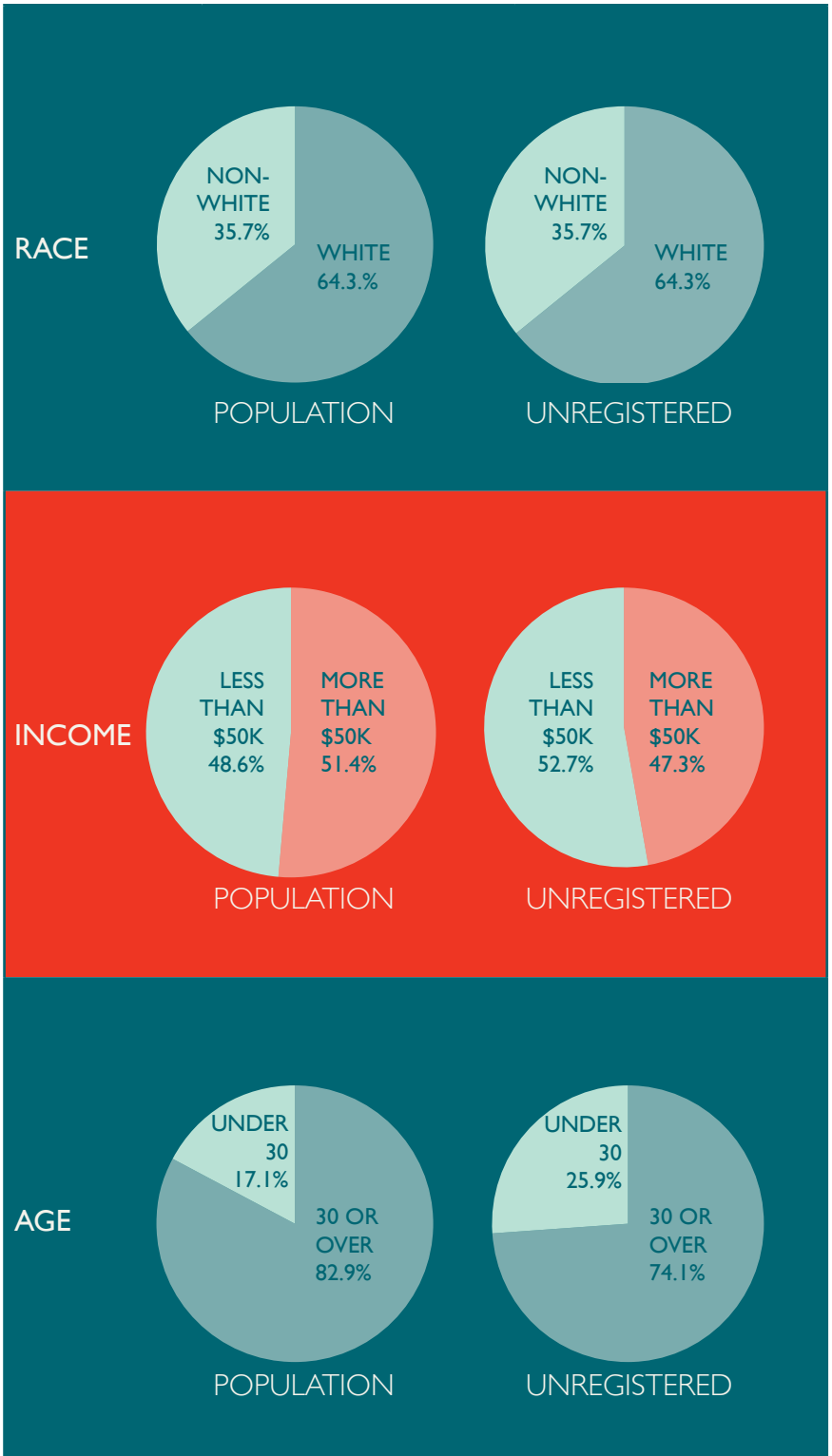

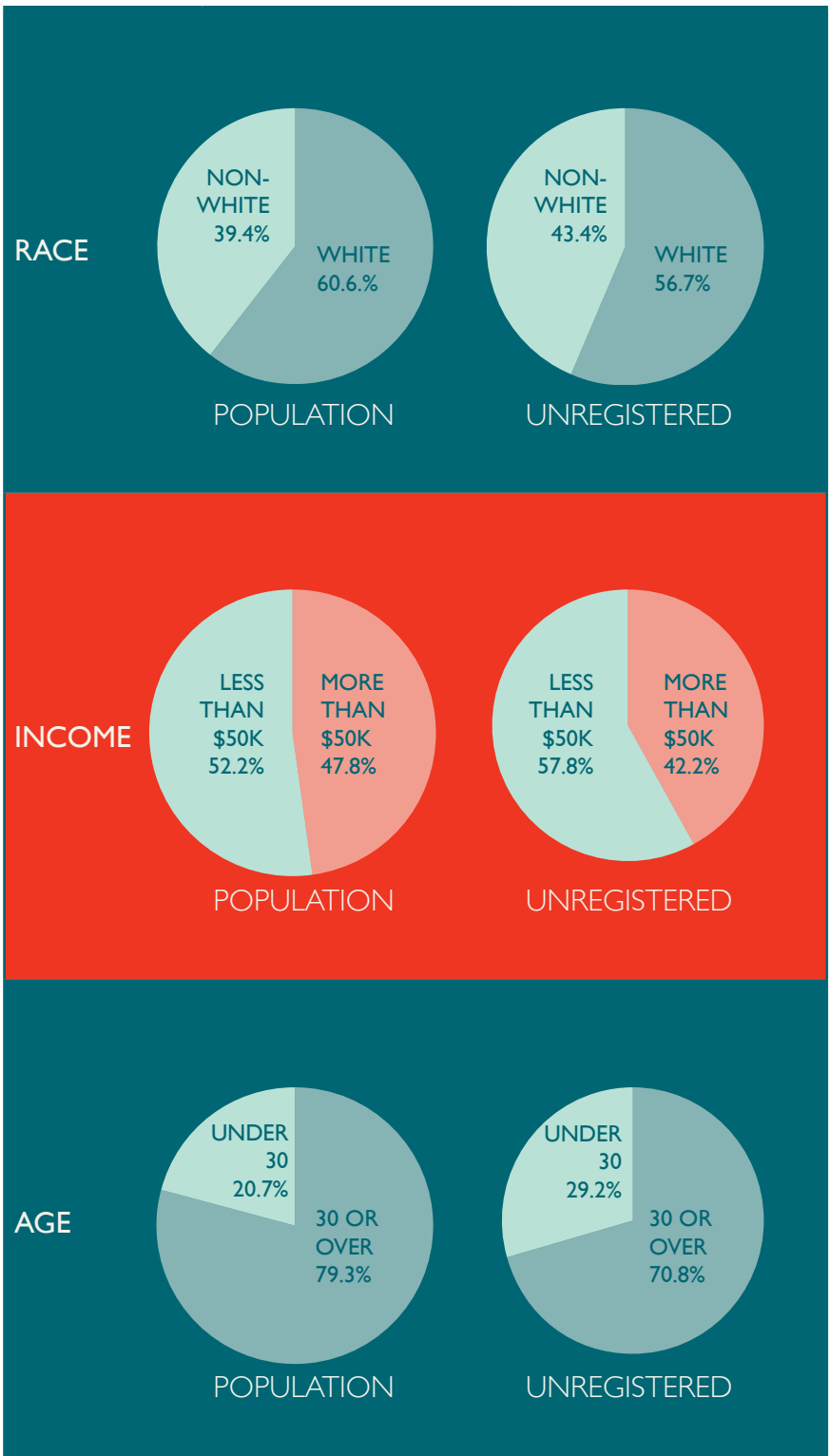

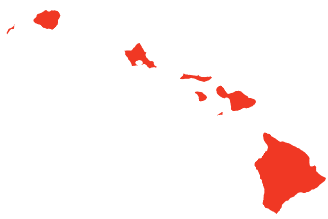
STATE'S ADULT CITIZEN POPULATION VS. STATE'S UNREGISTERED POPULATION, 2014

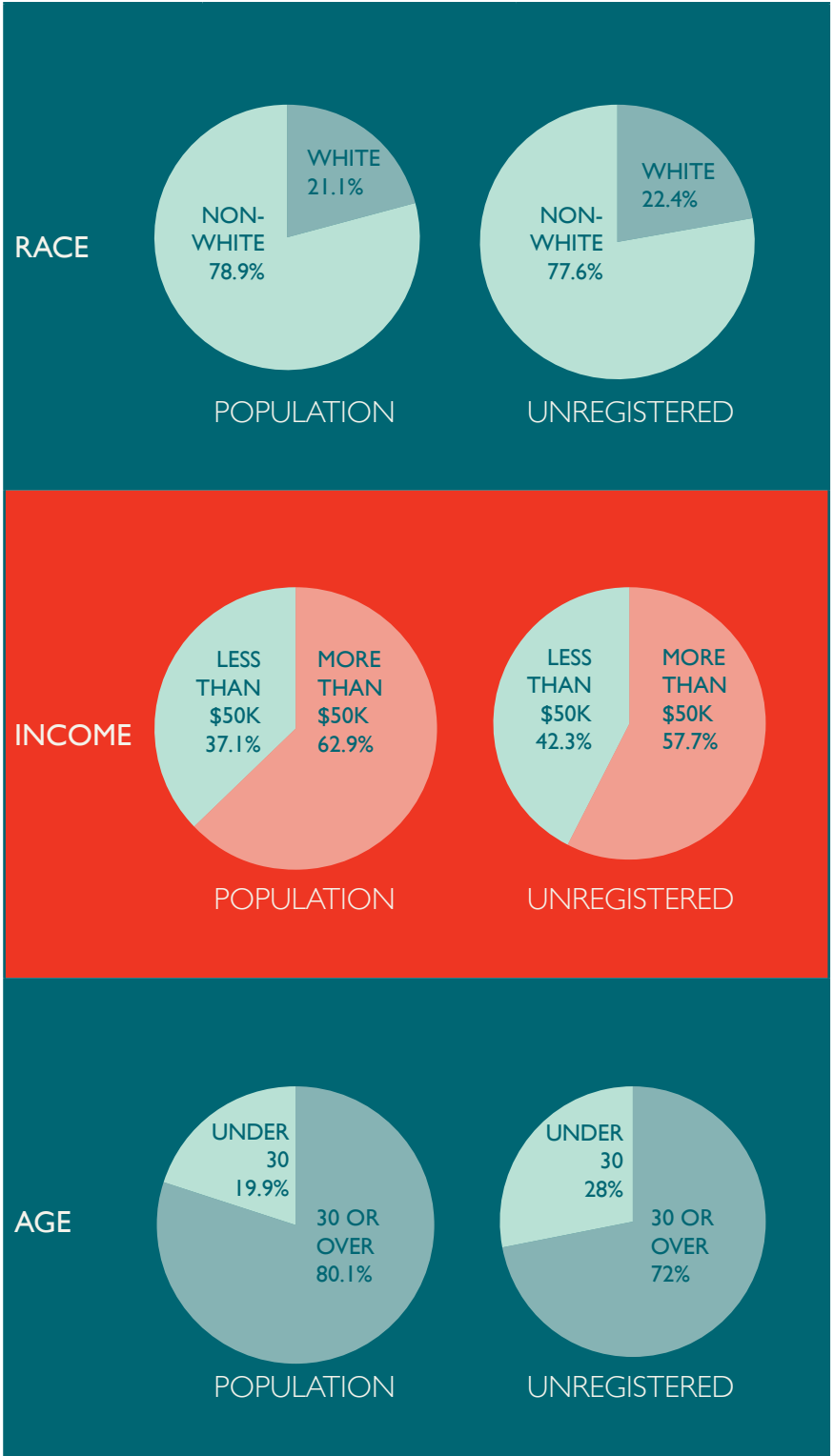

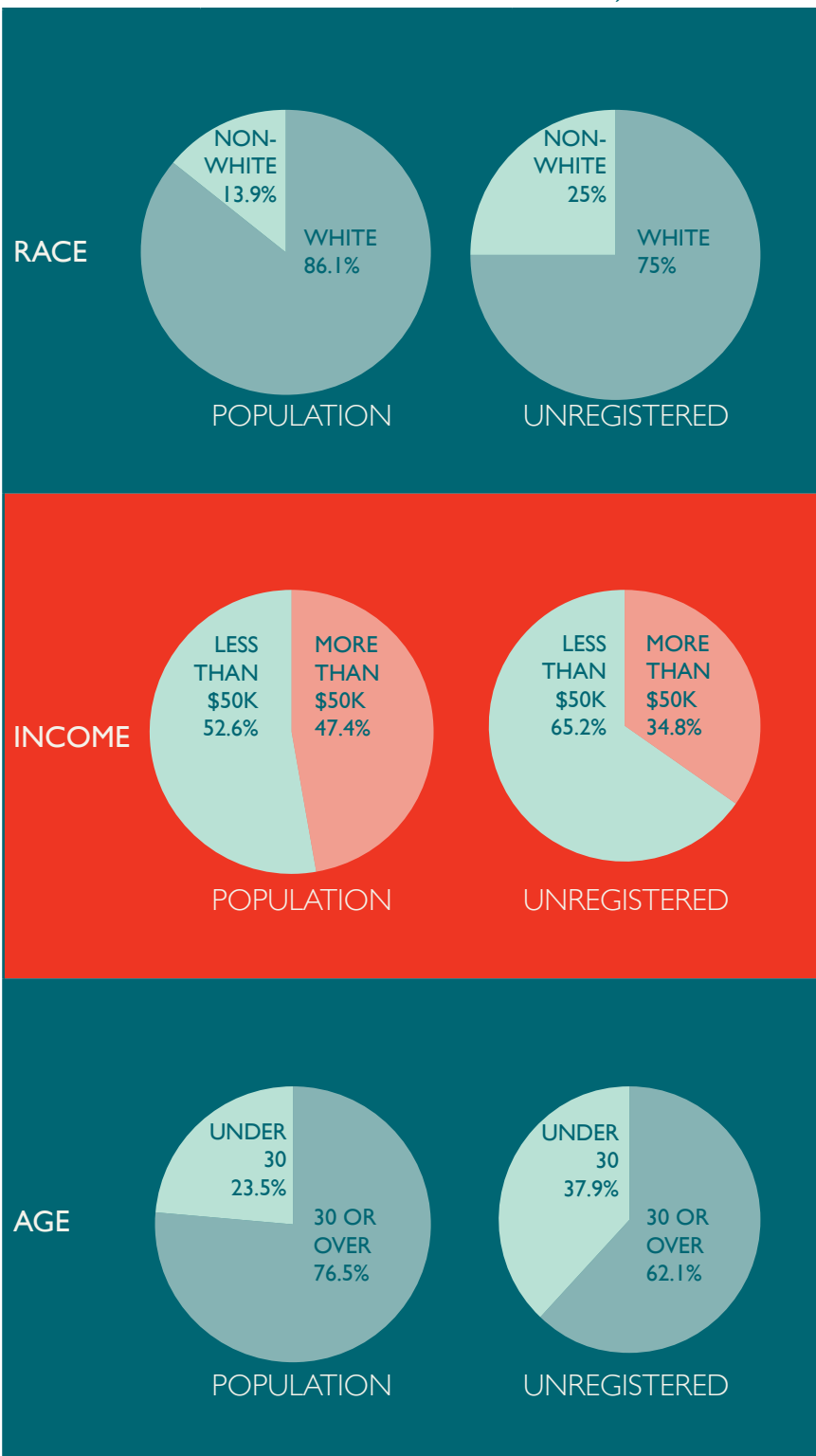

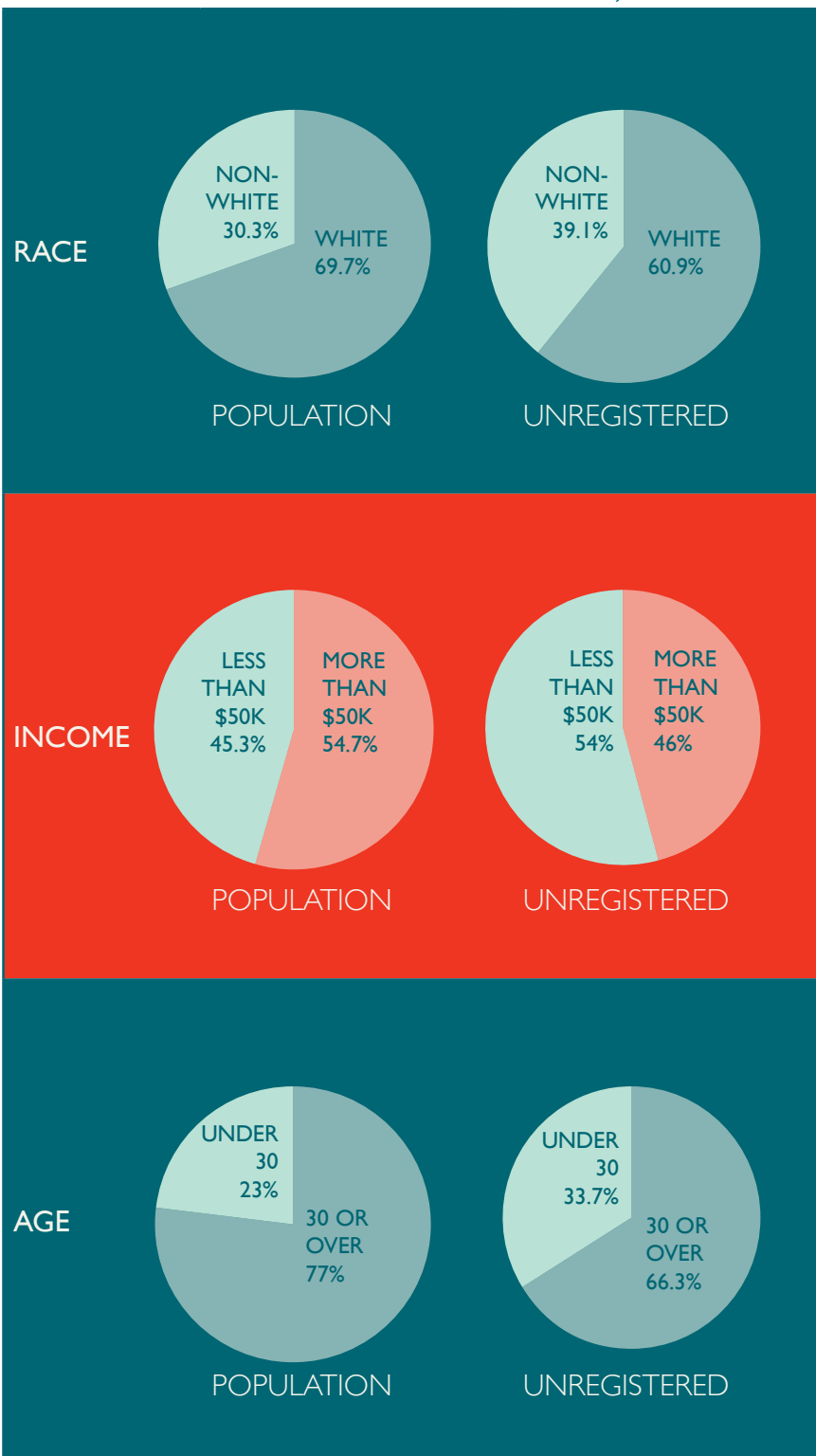

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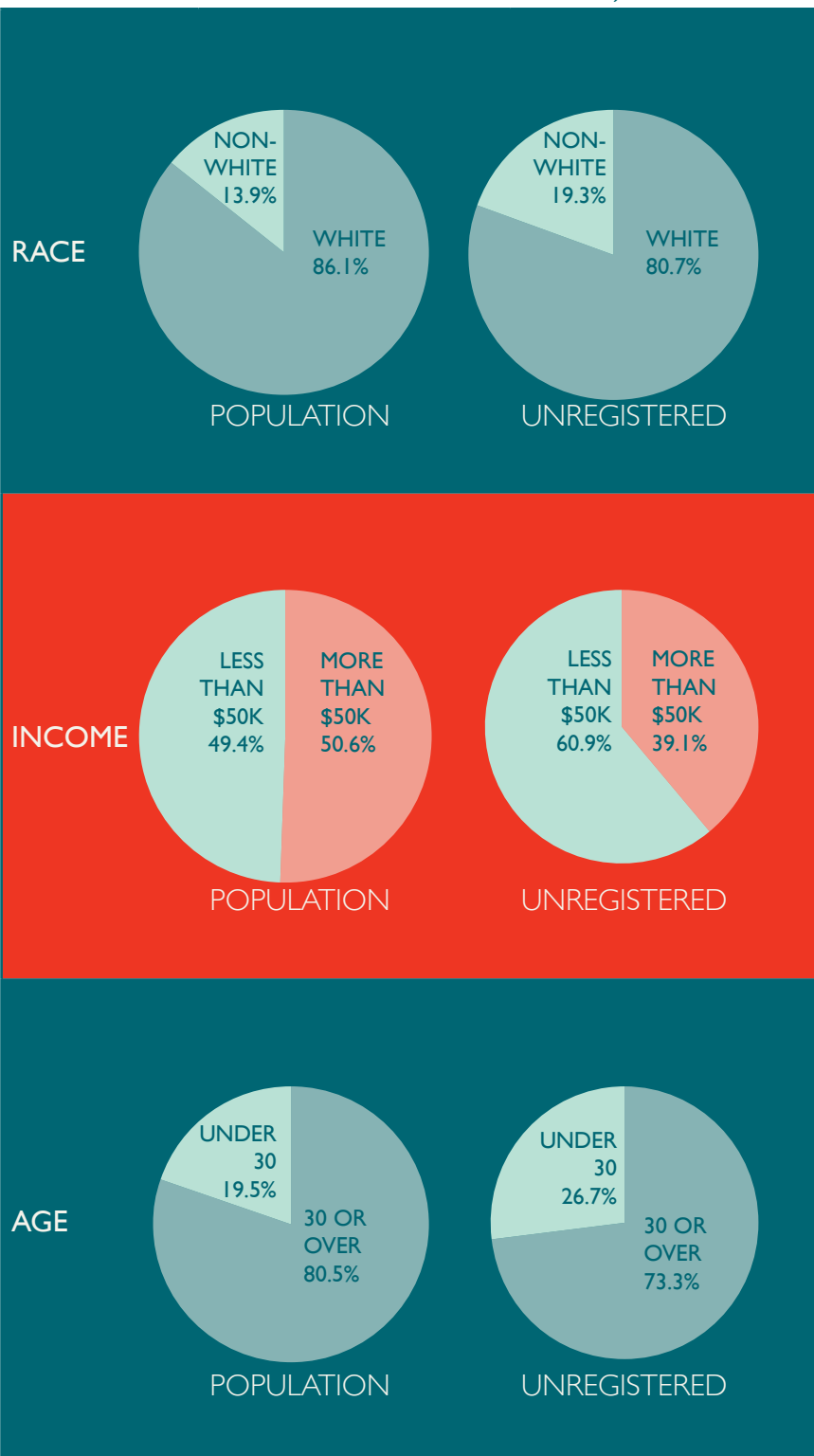

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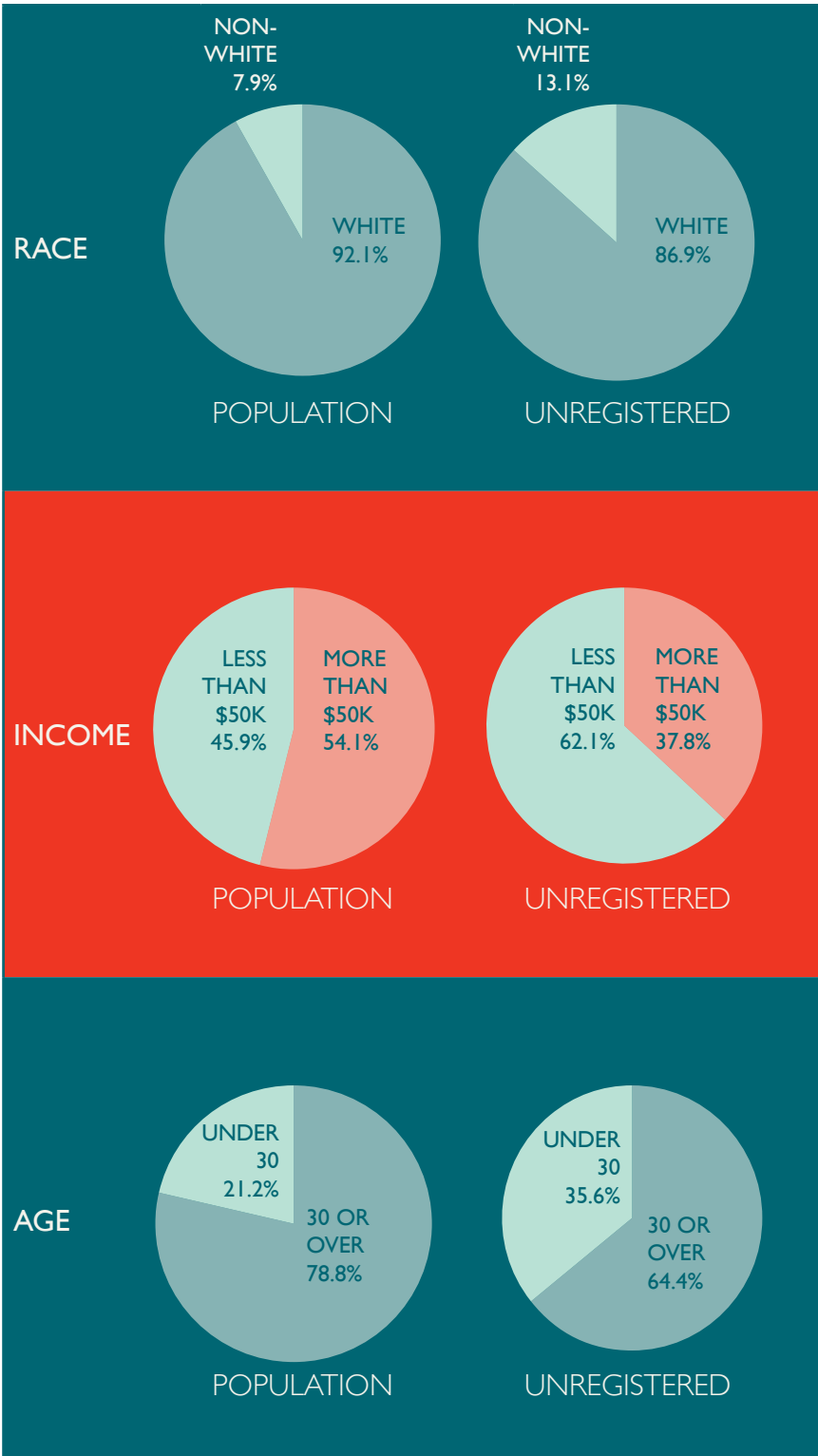

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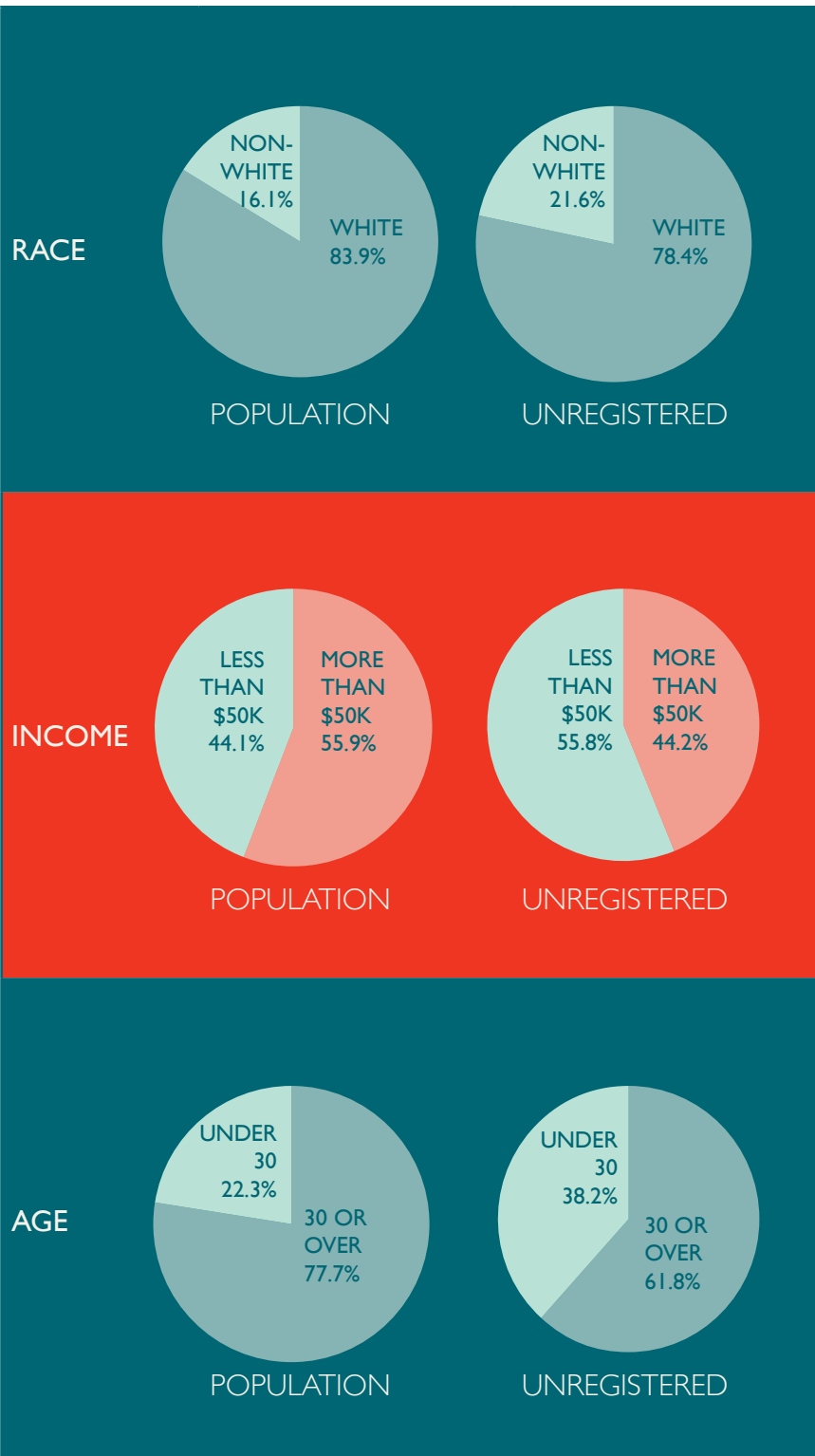

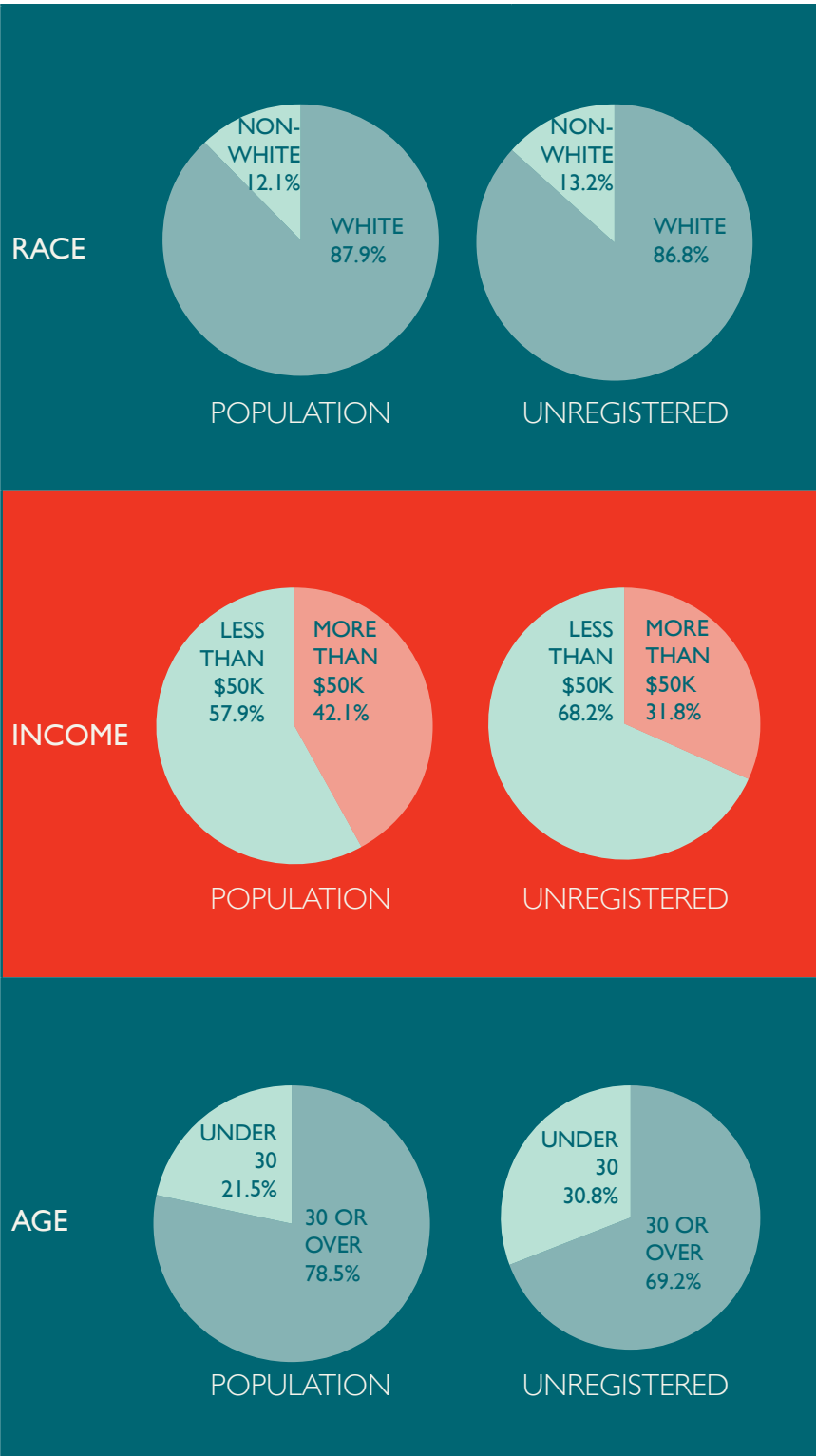

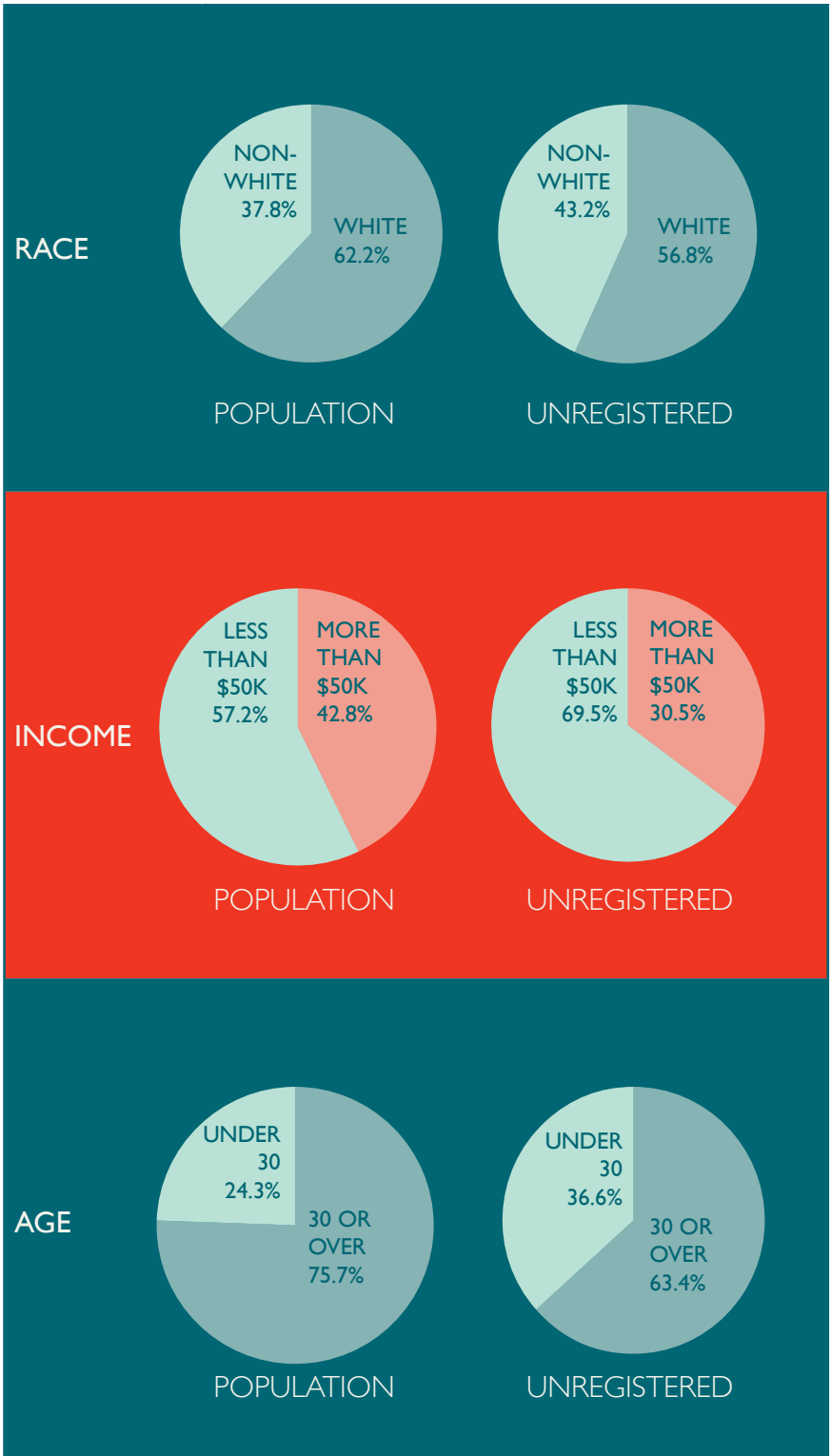

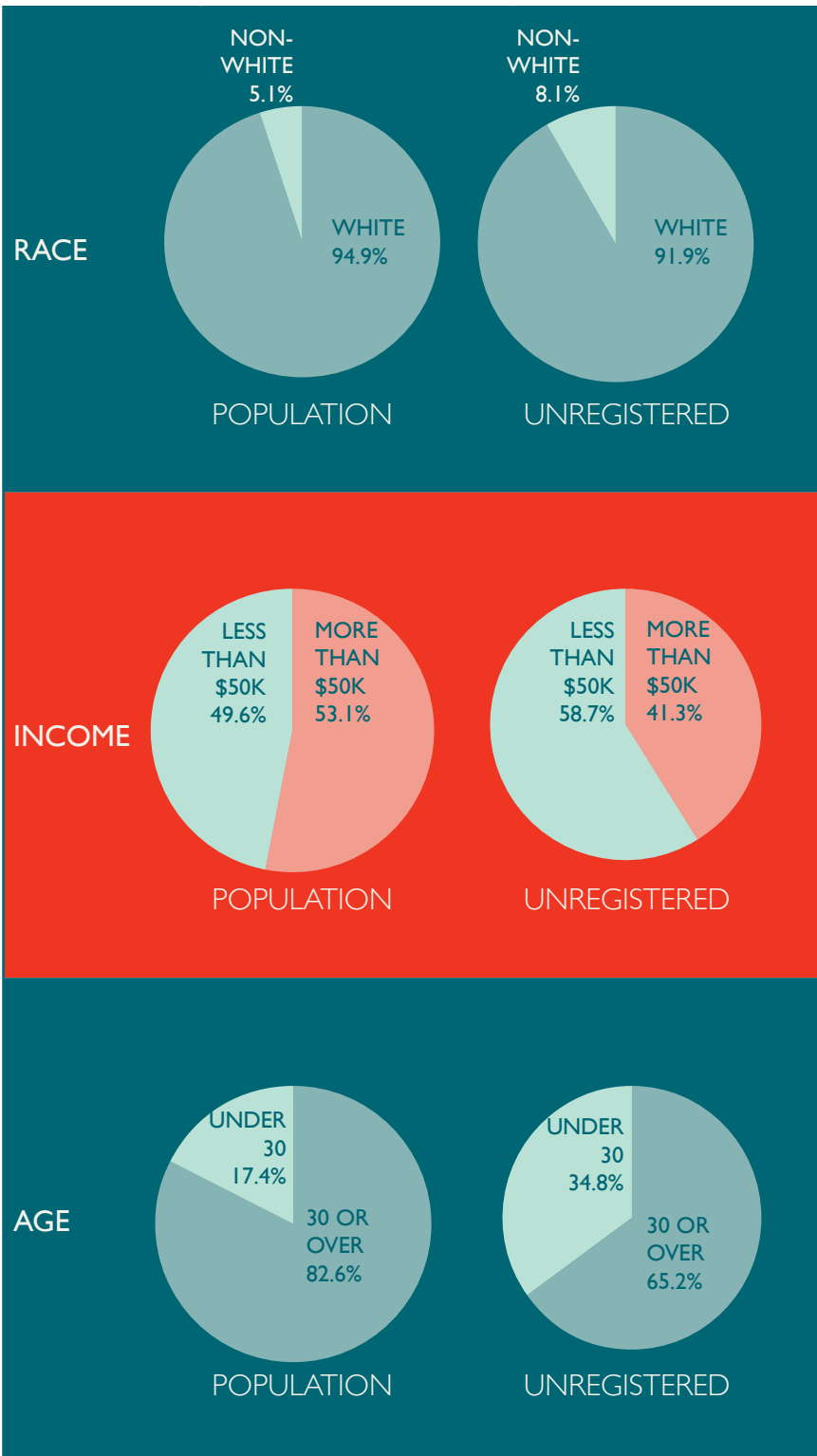

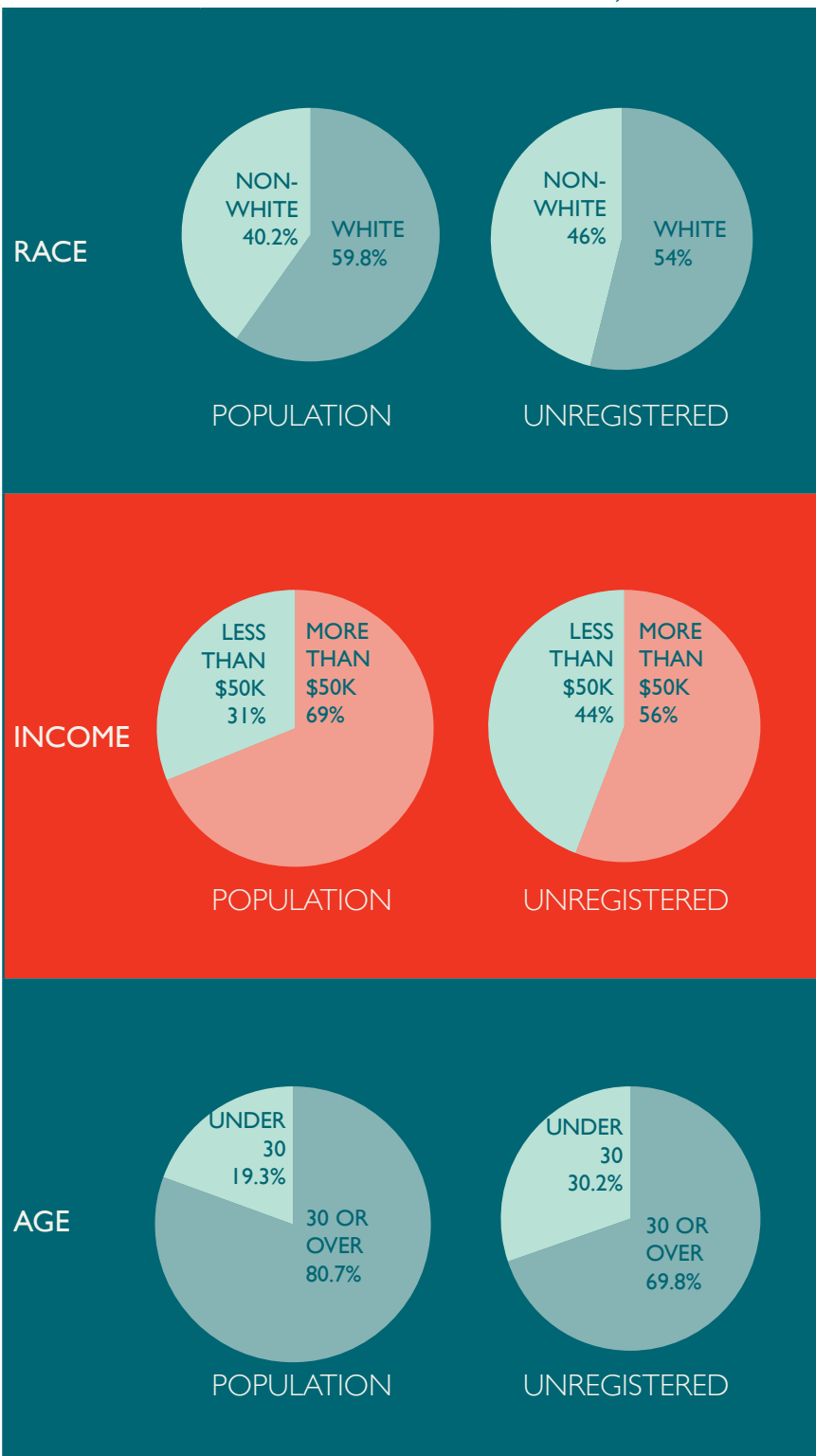

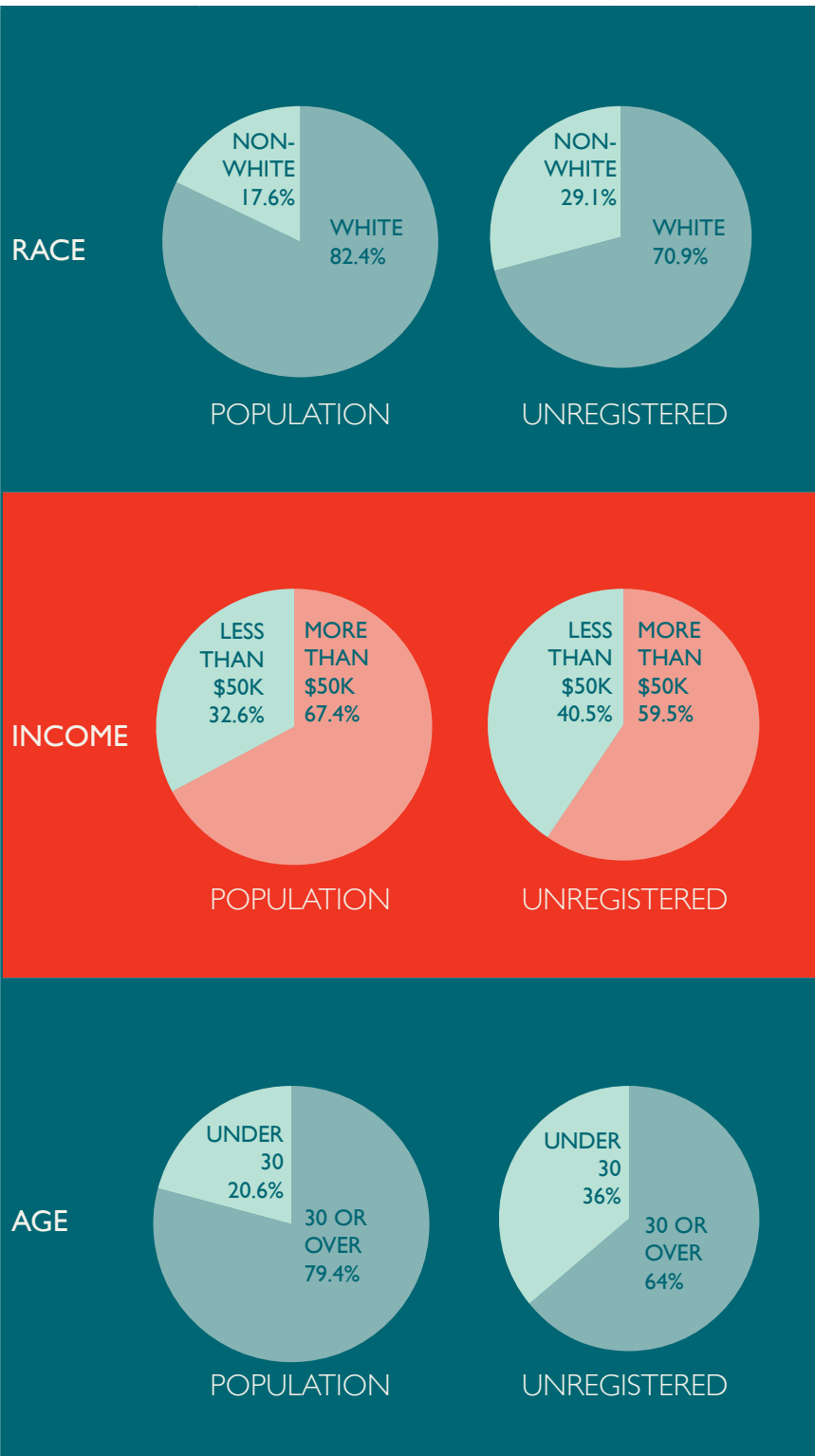

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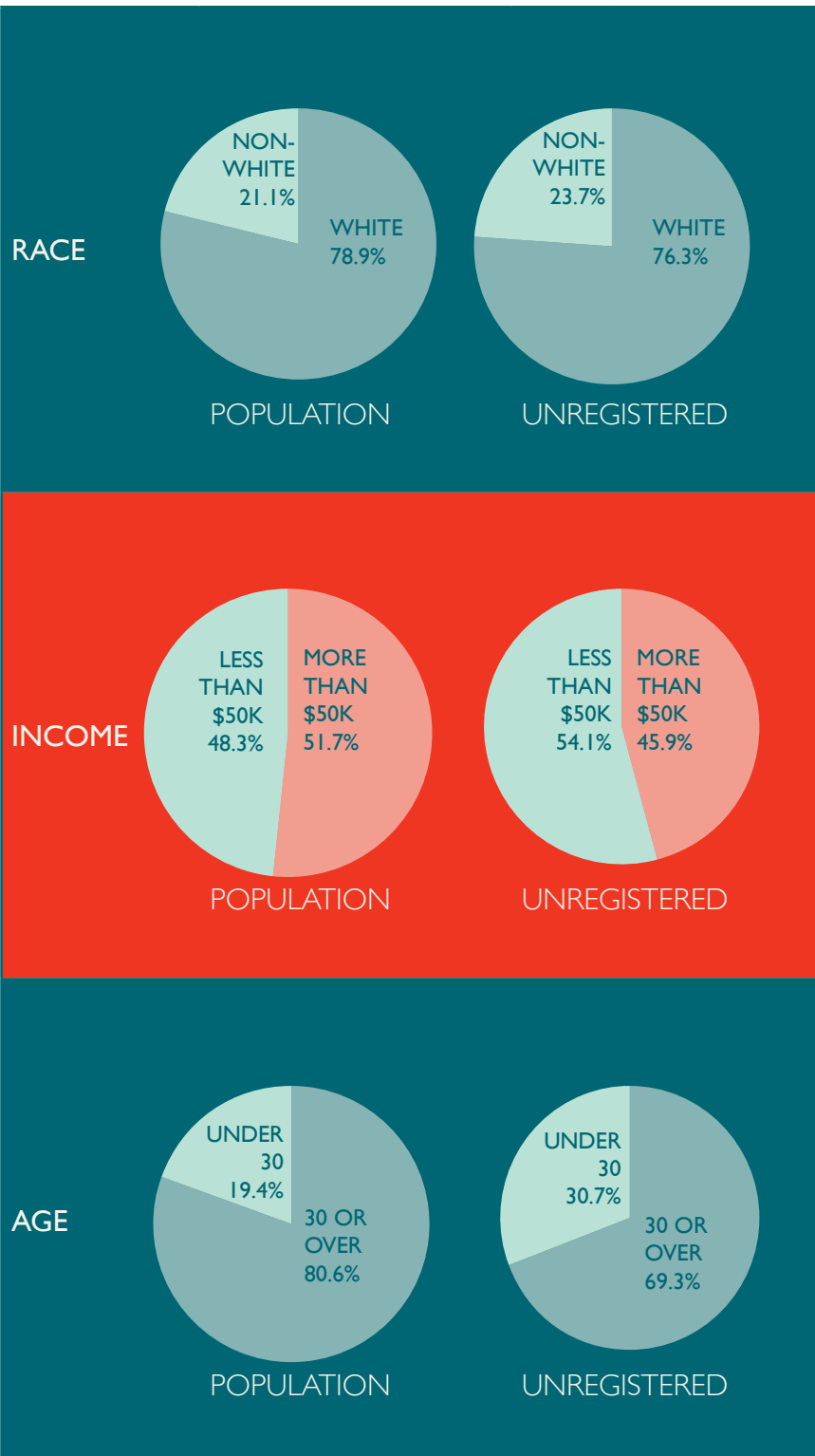

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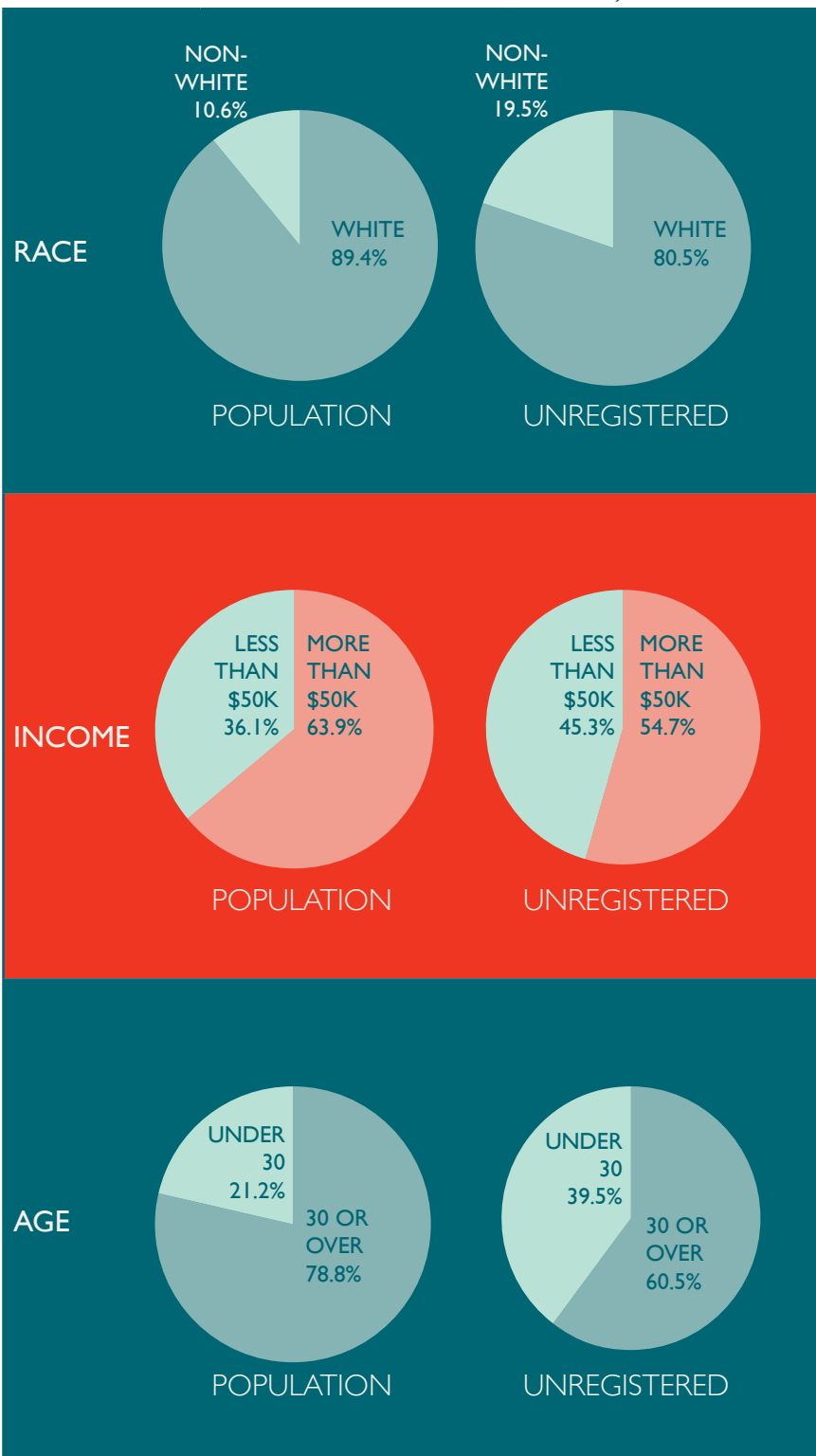

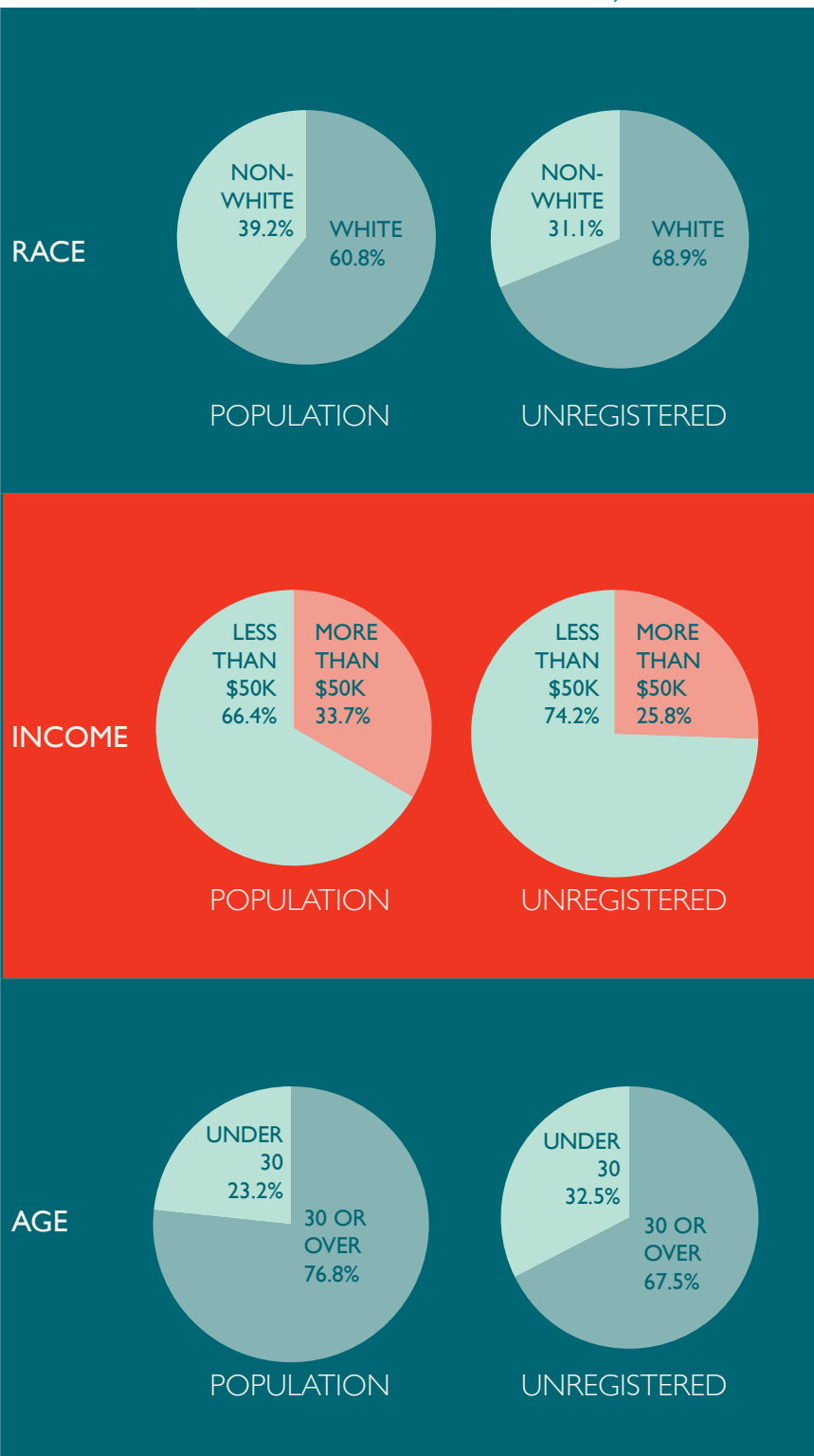

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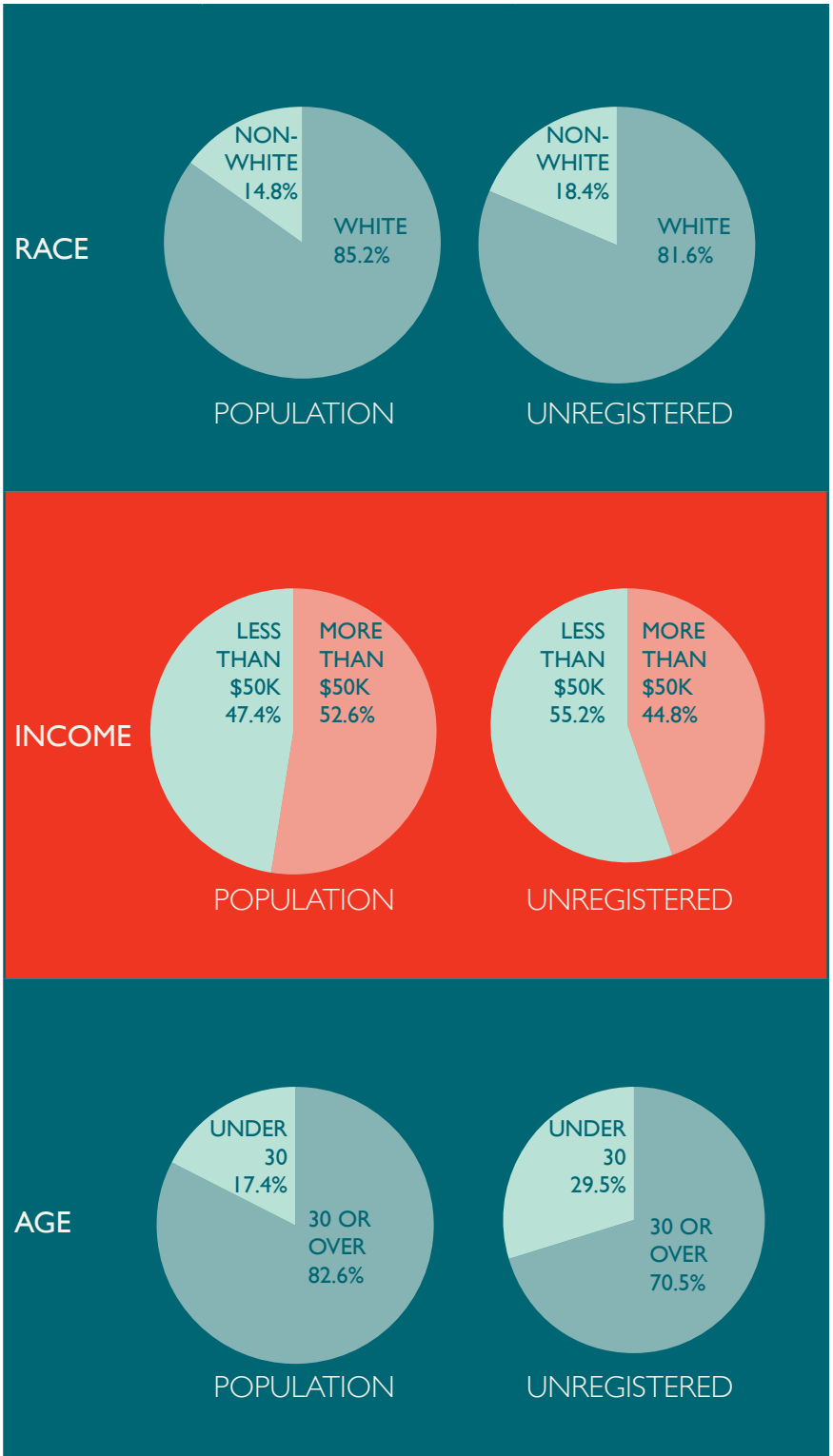

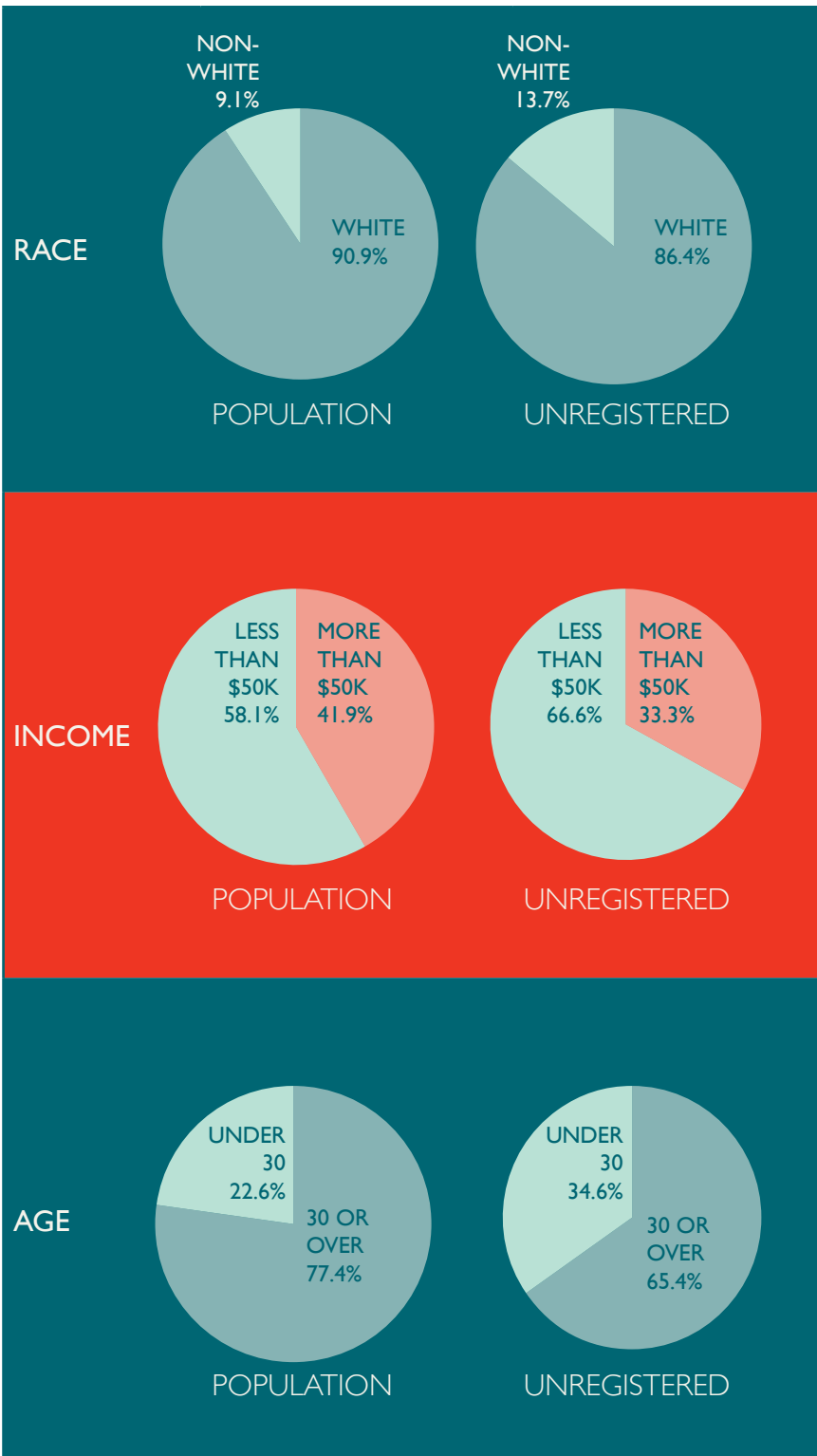

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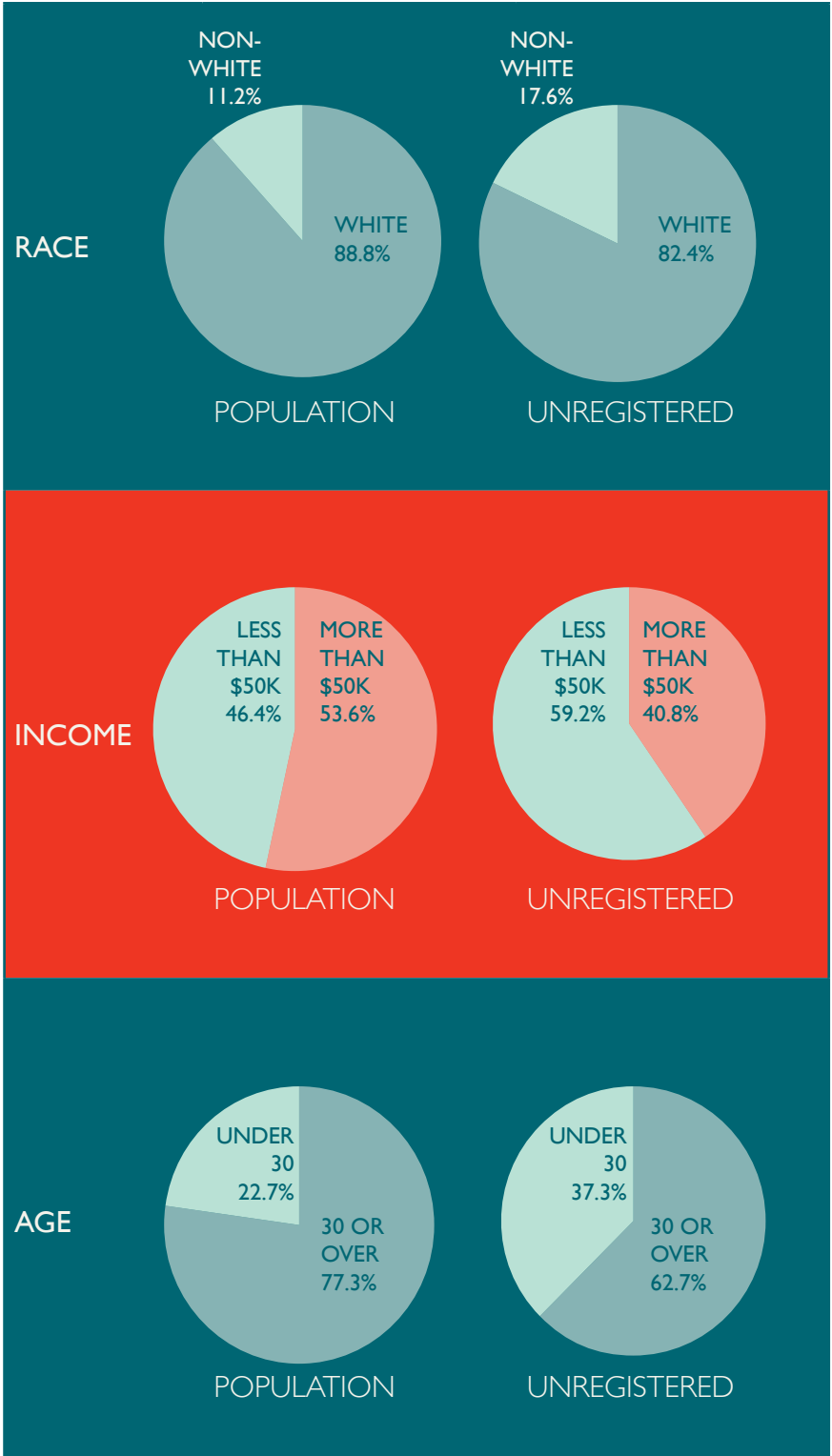

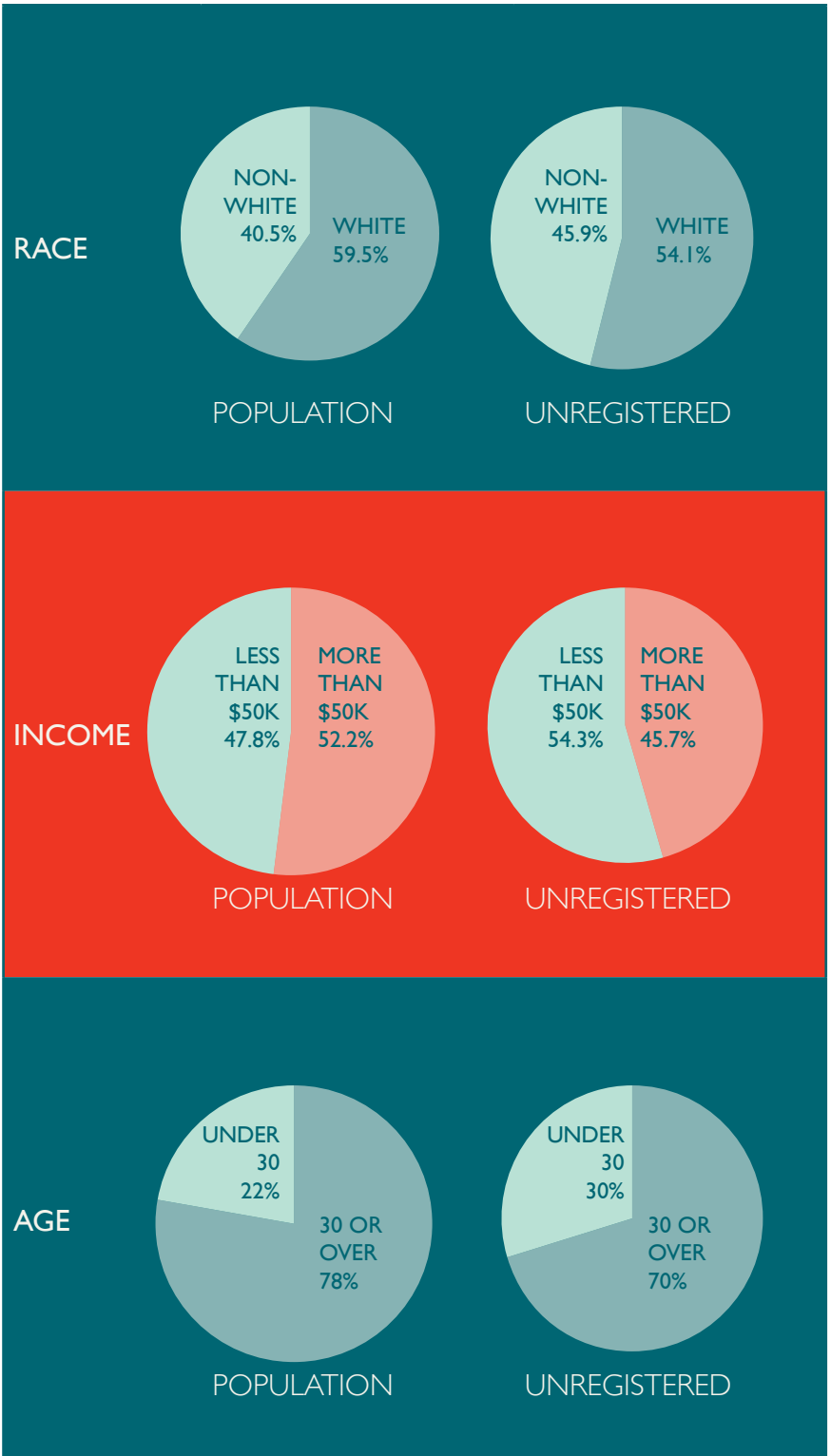

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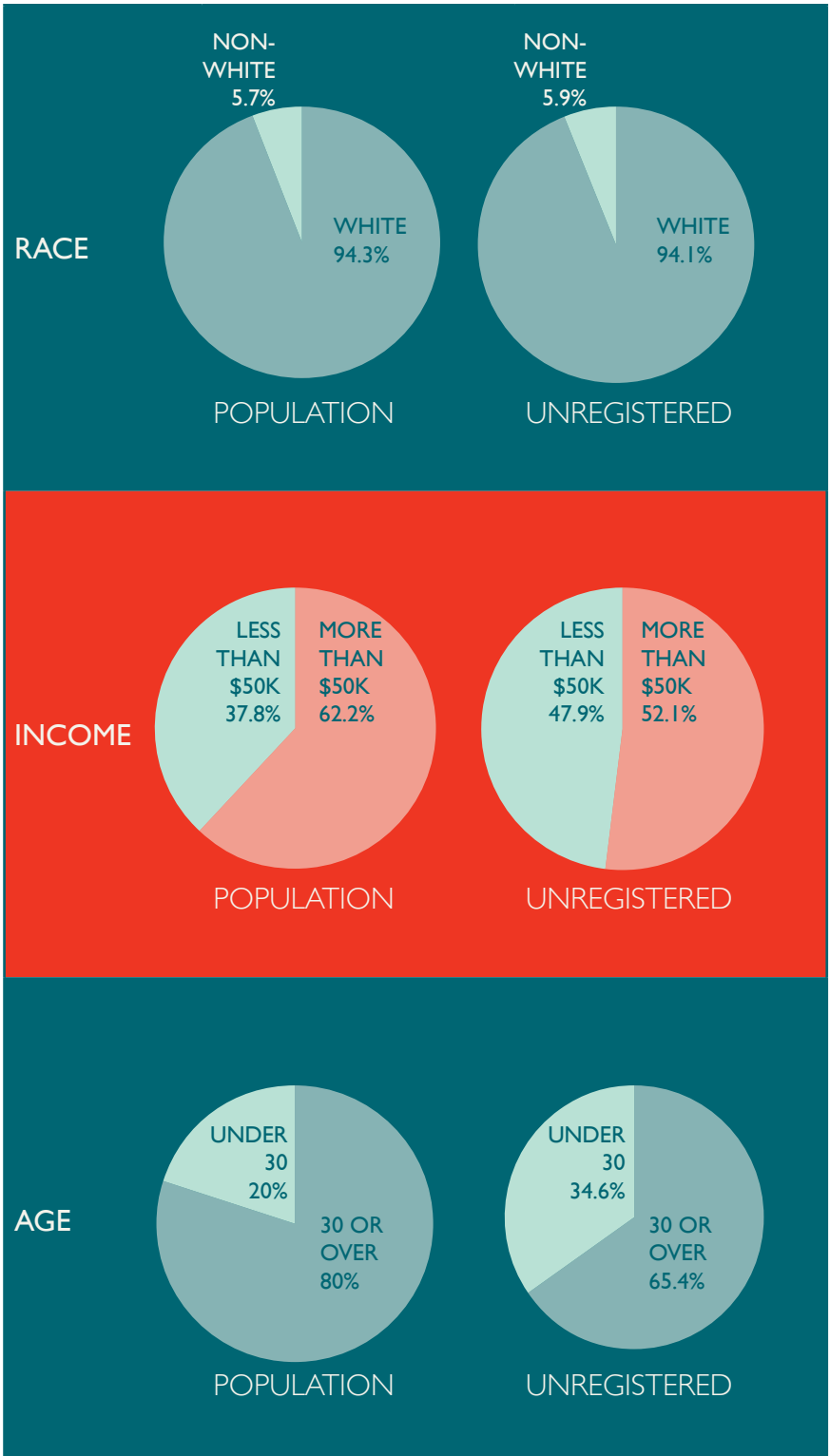

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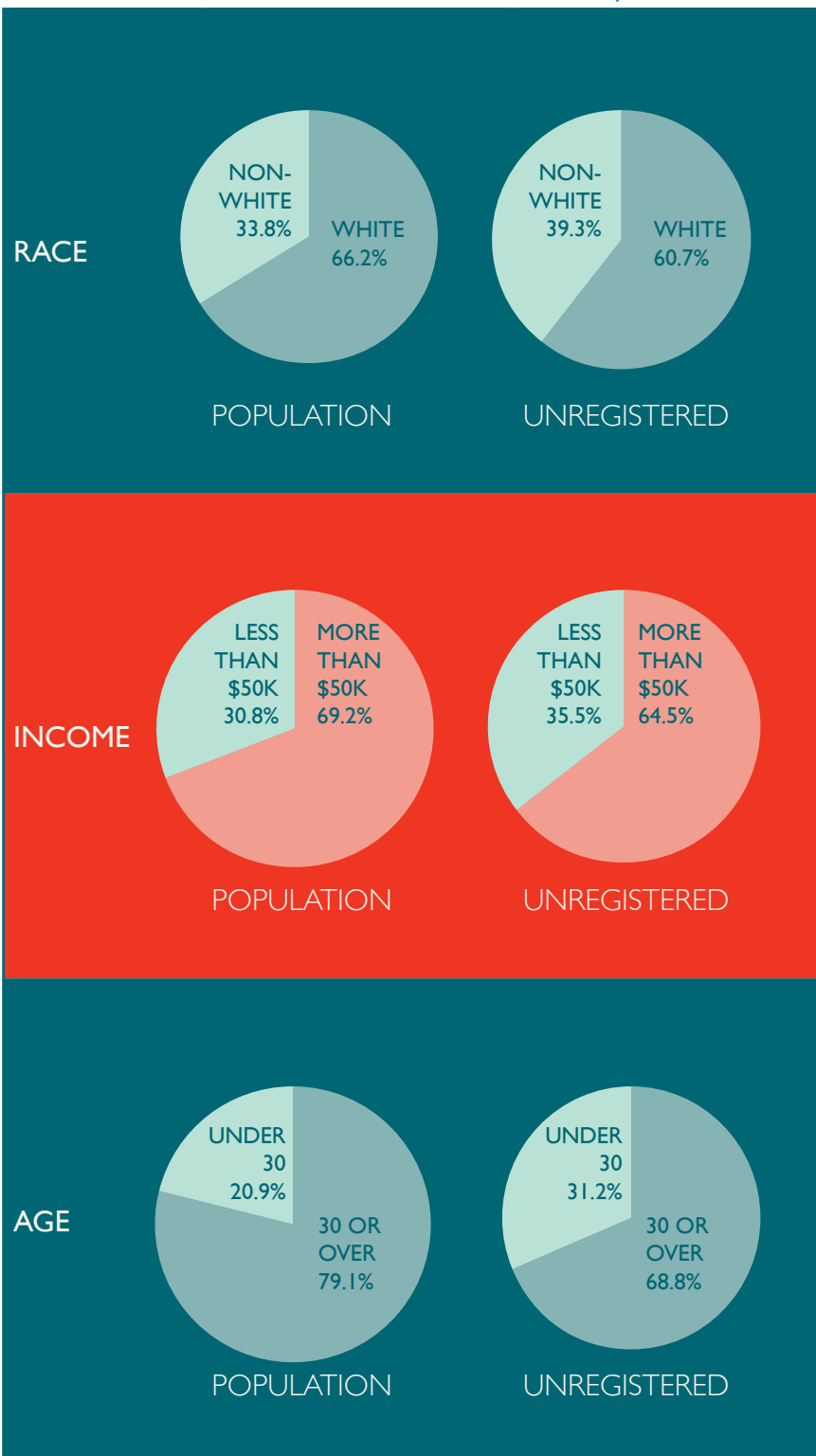

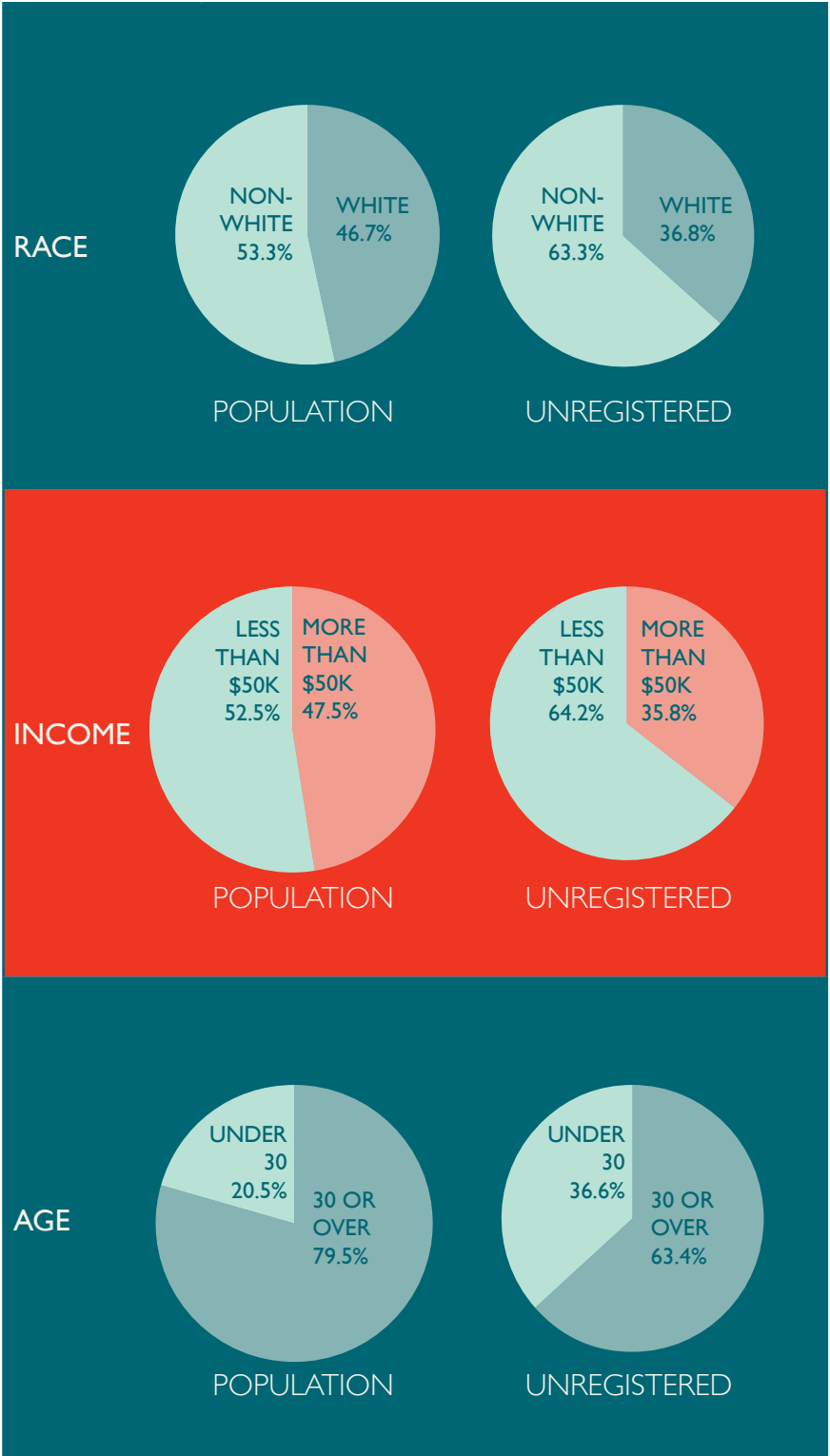

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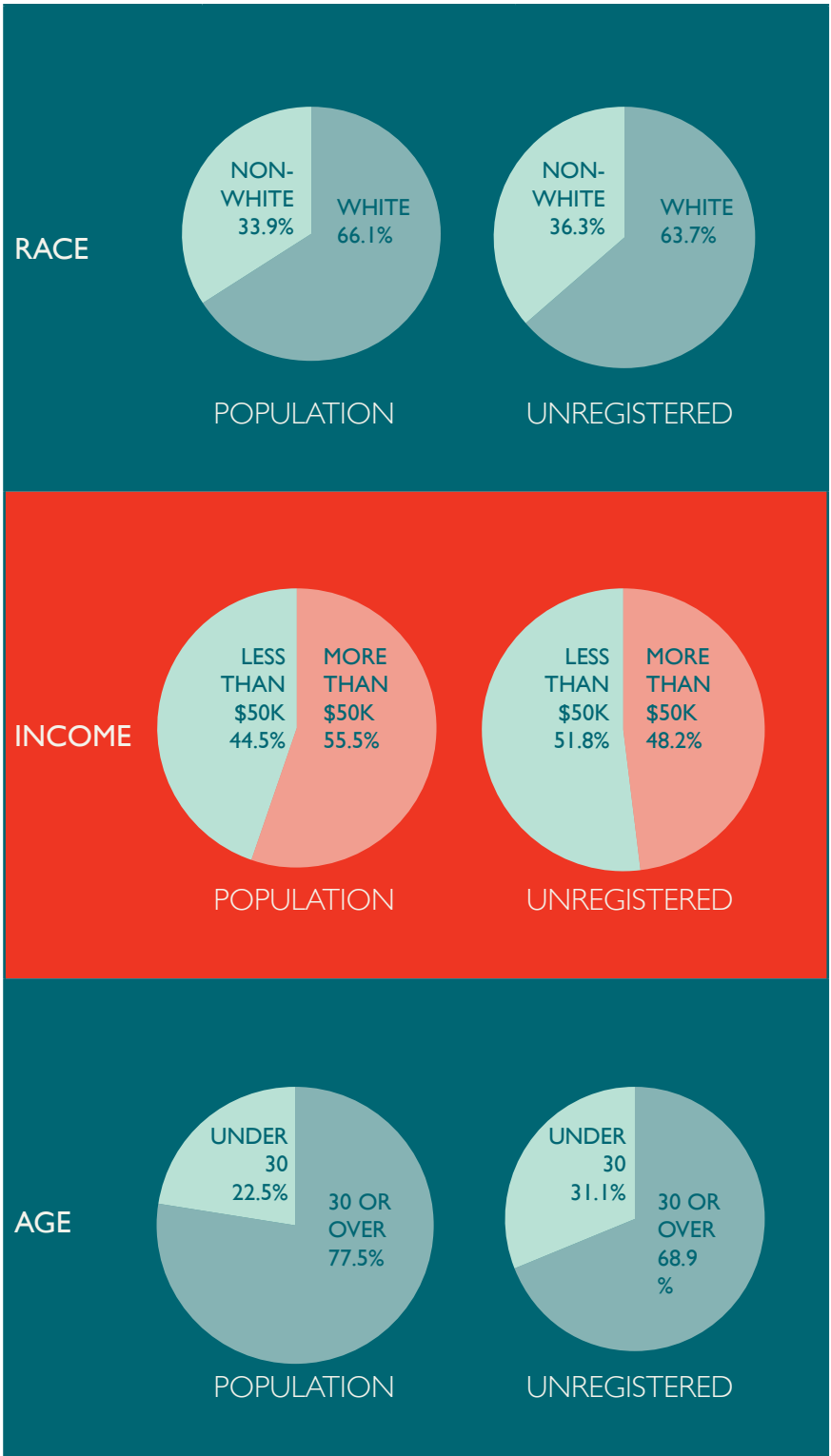

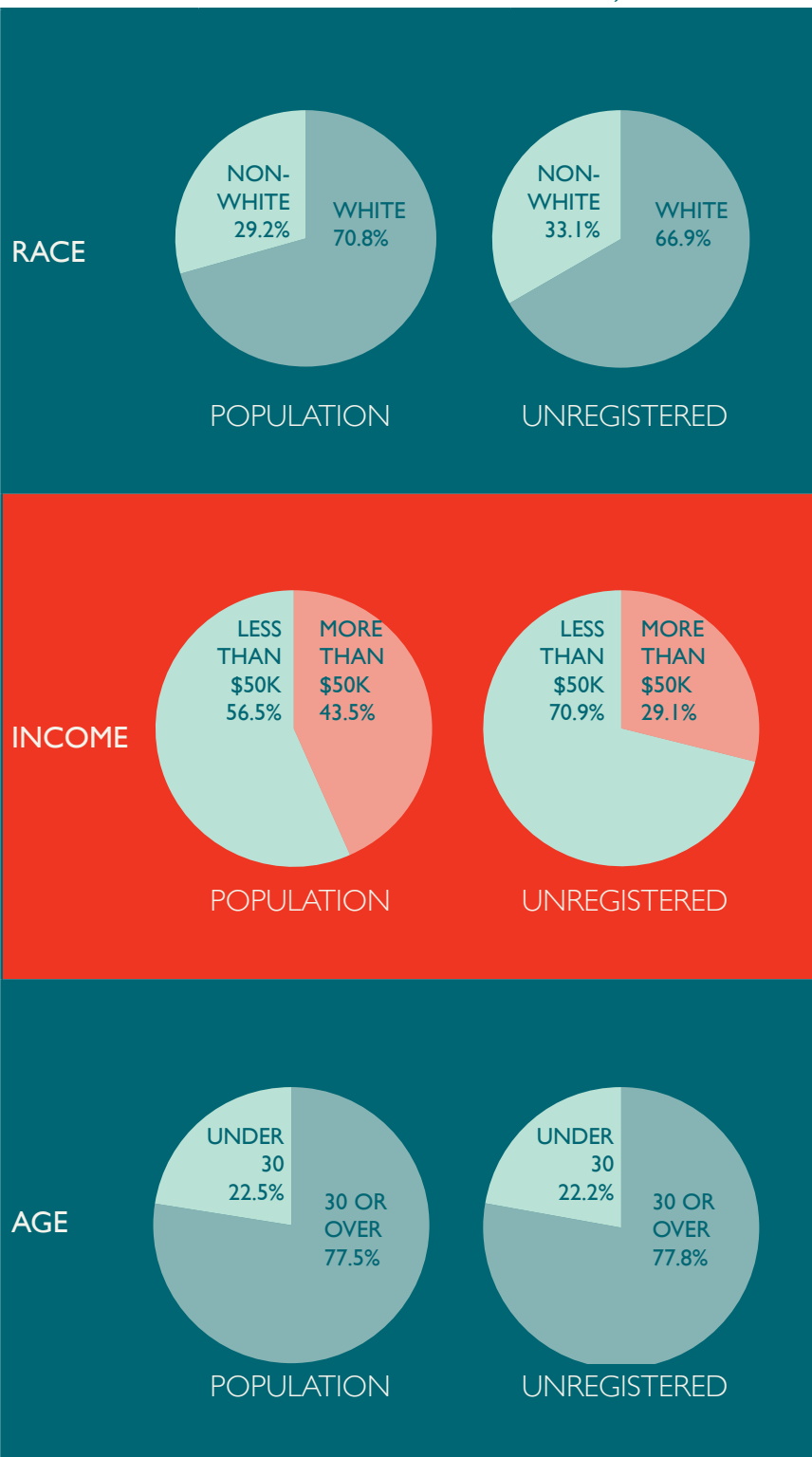

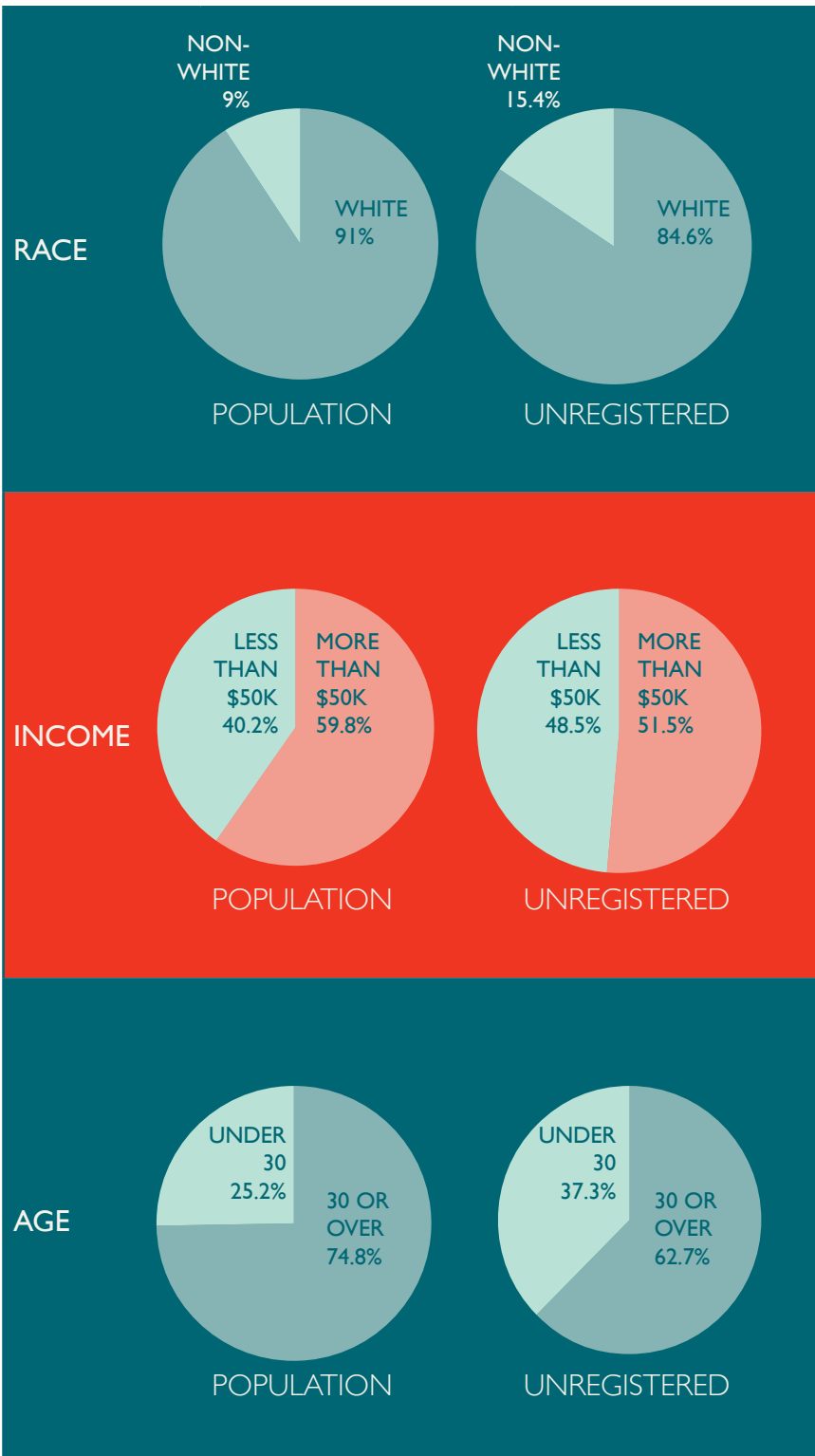

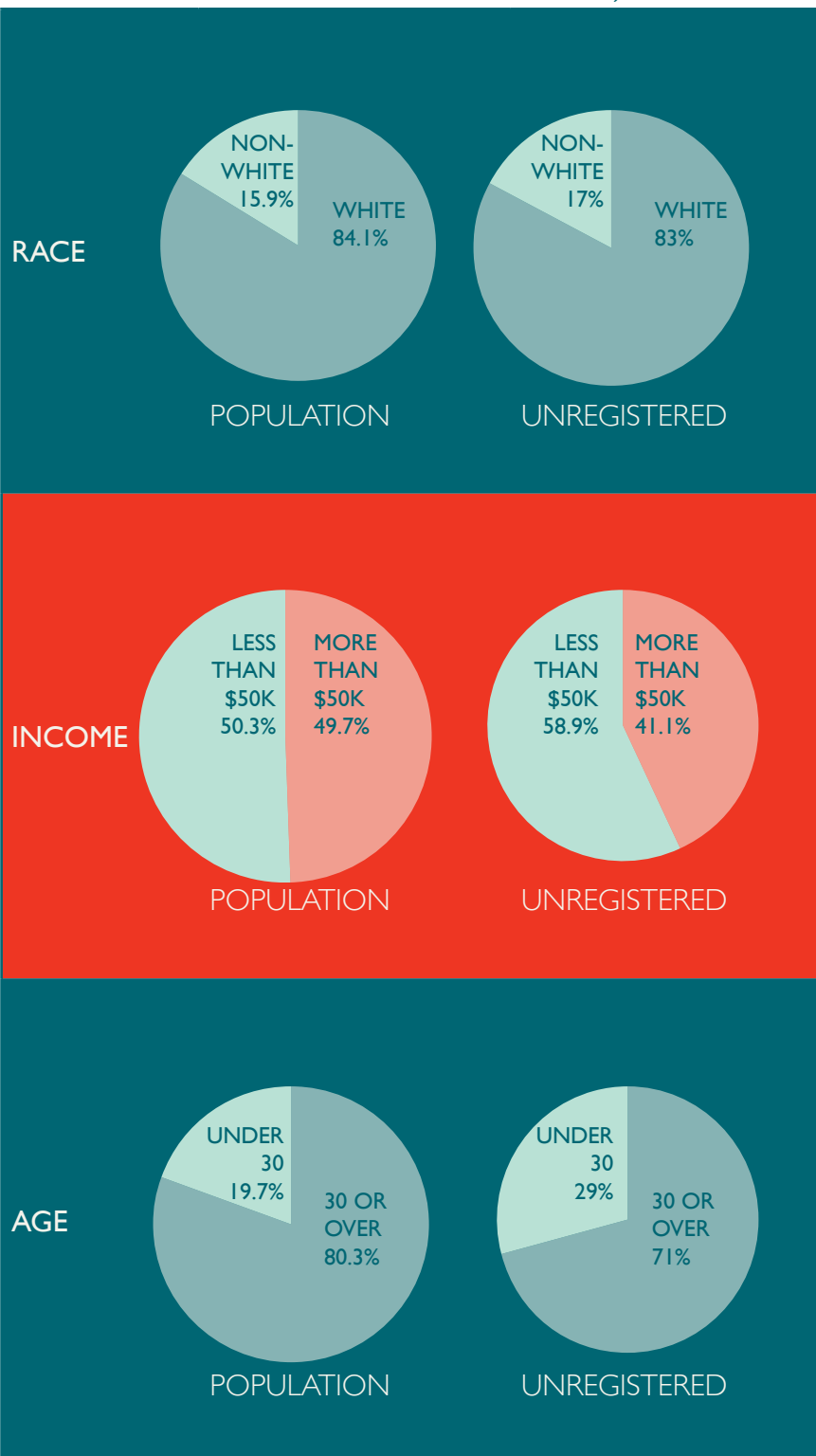

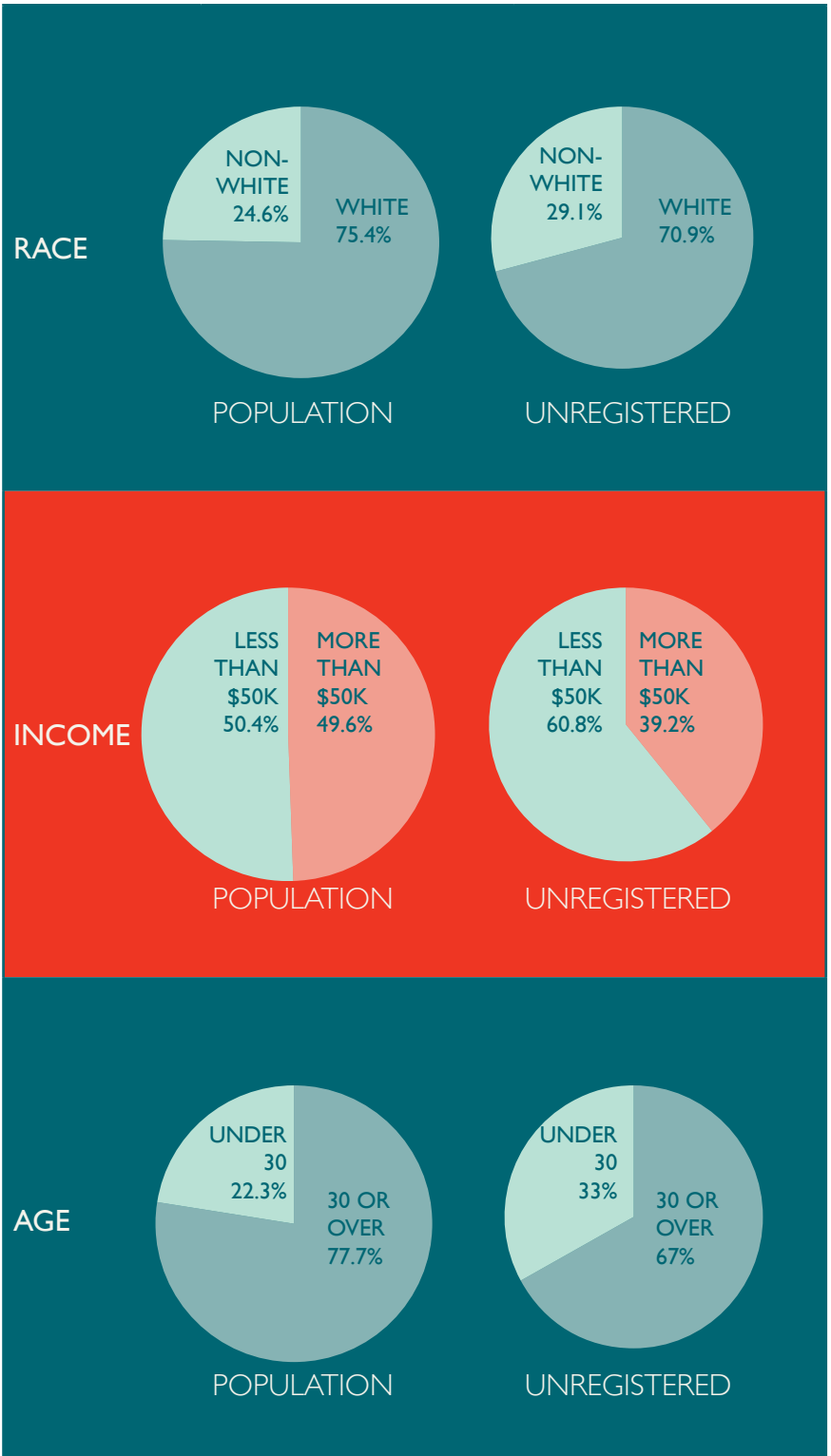

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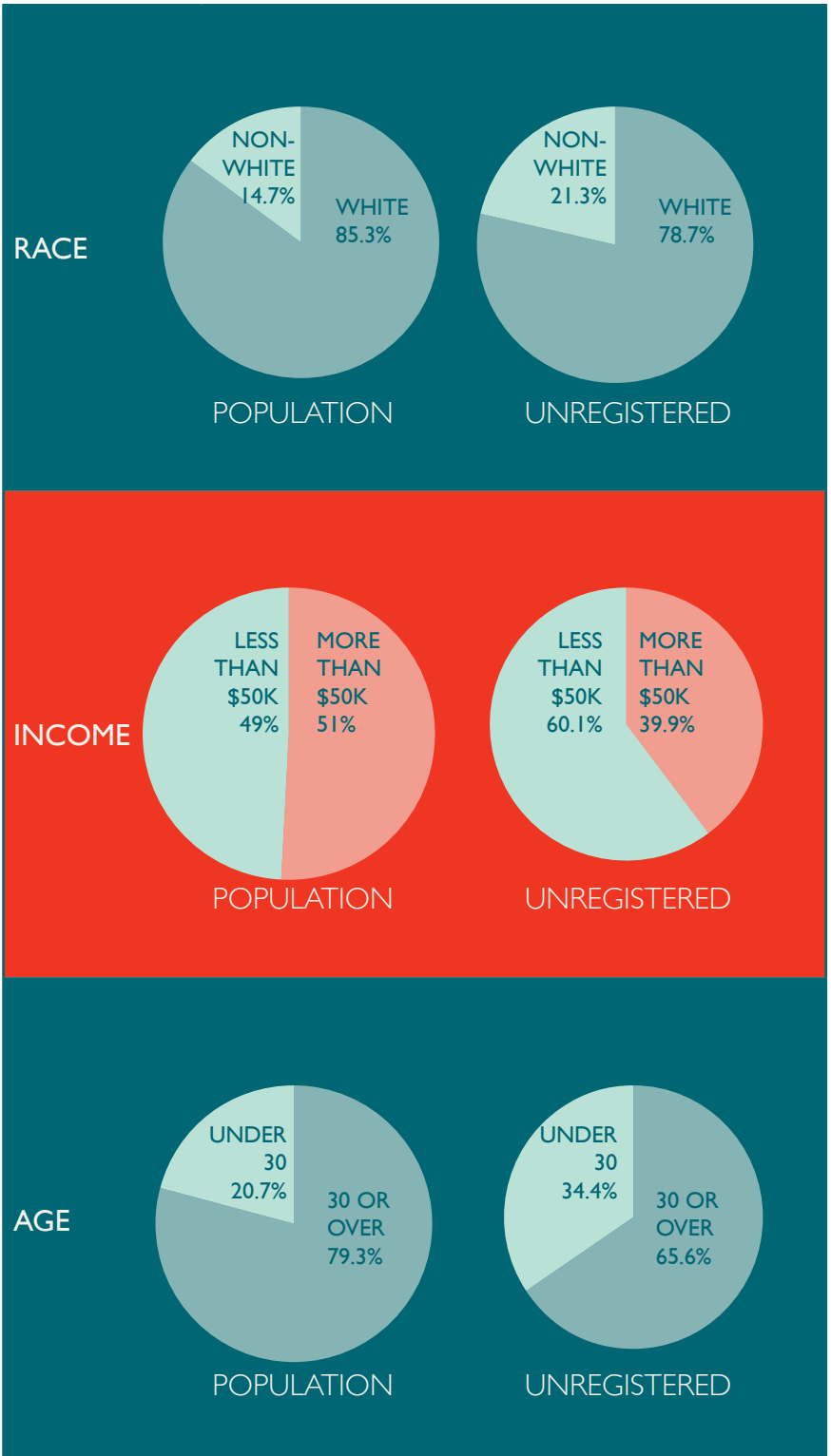

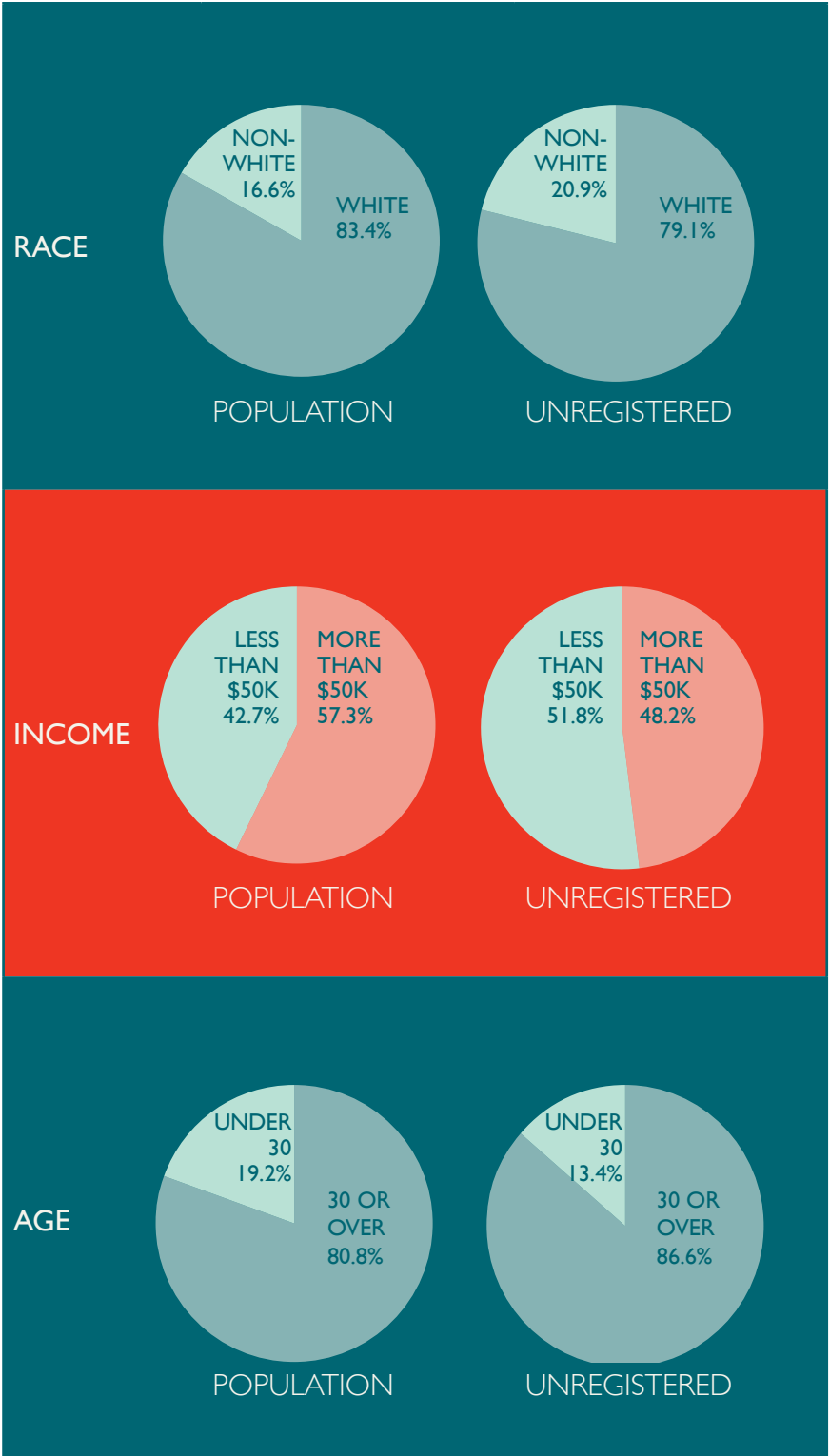

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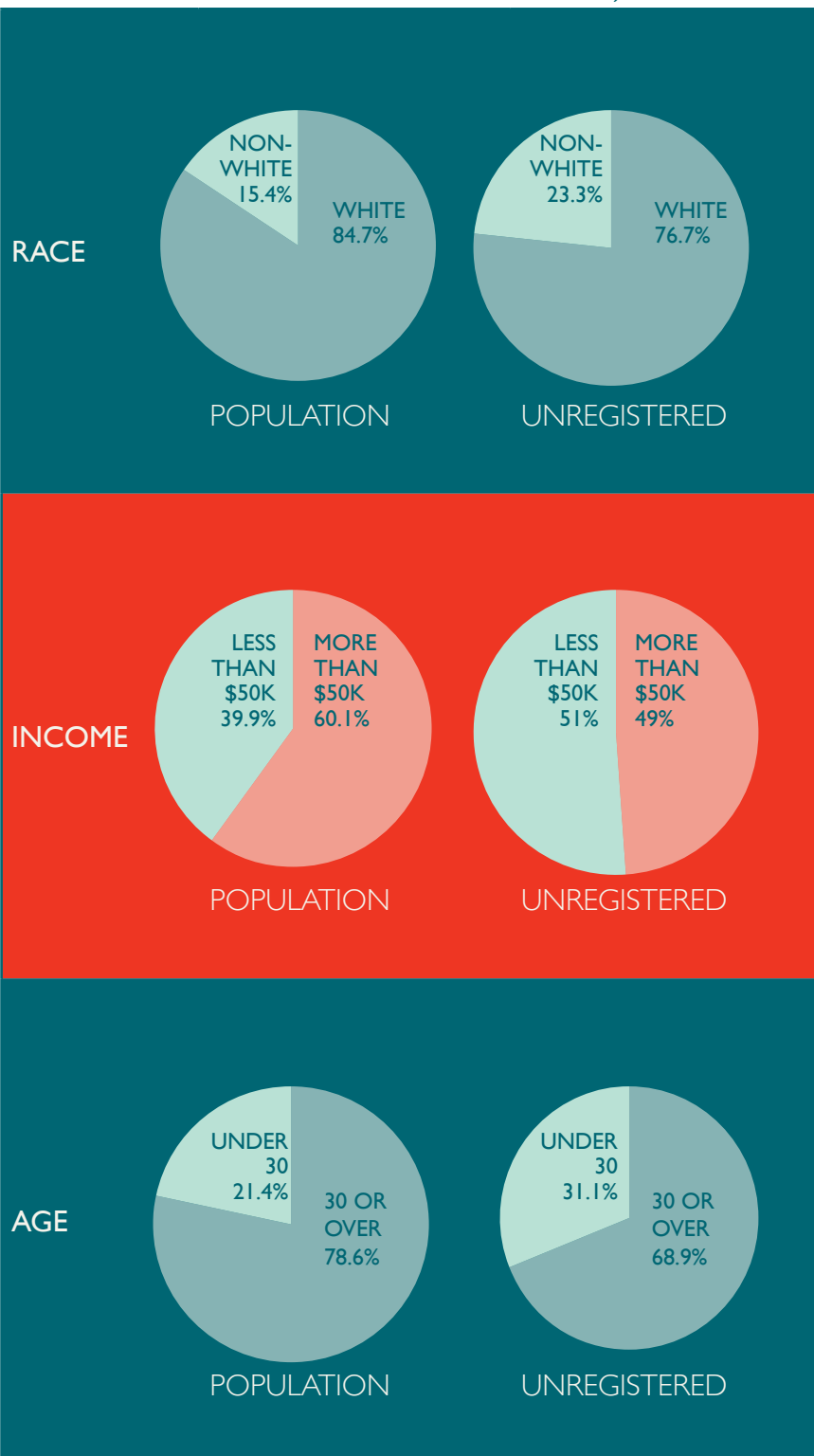

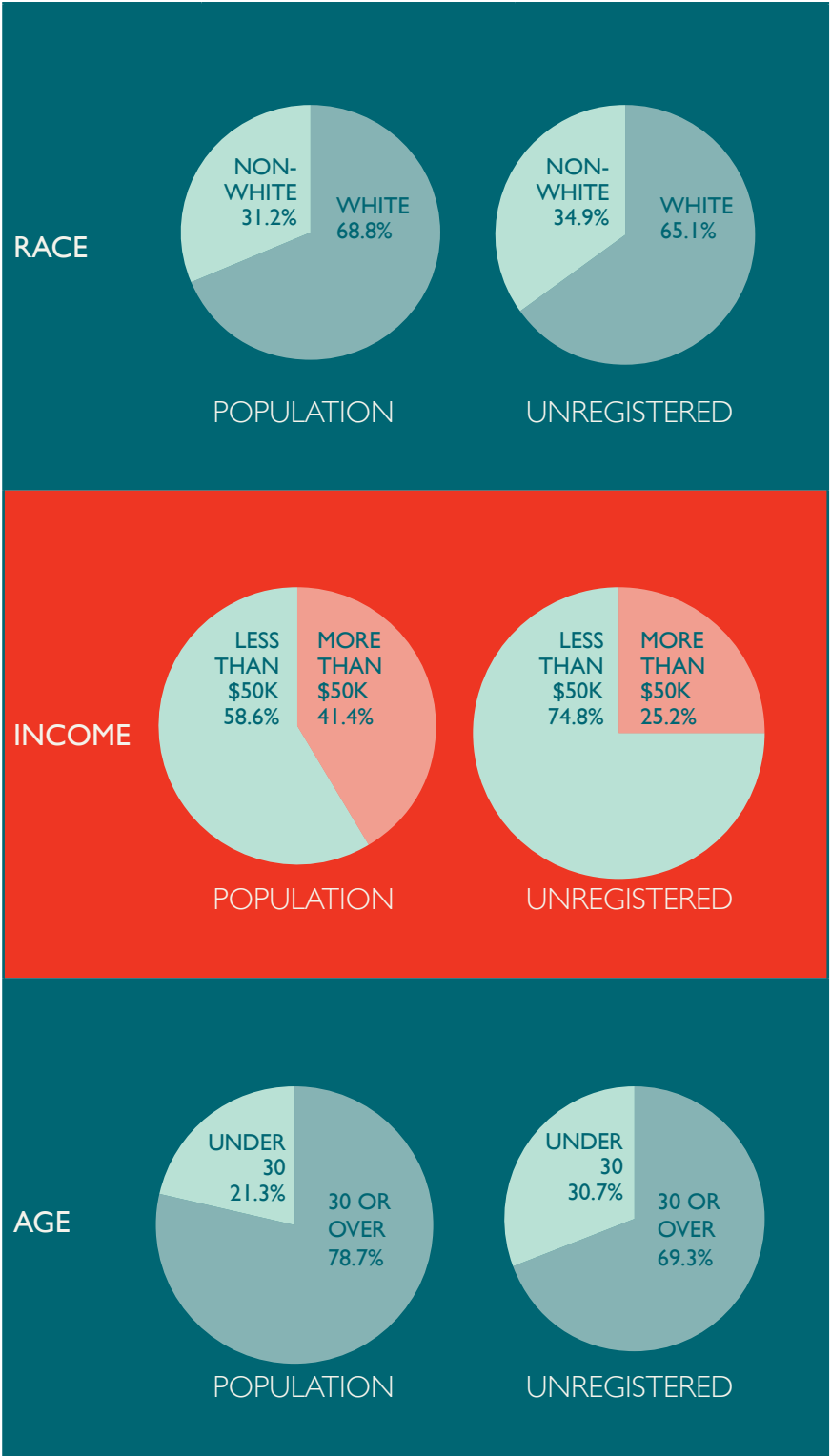

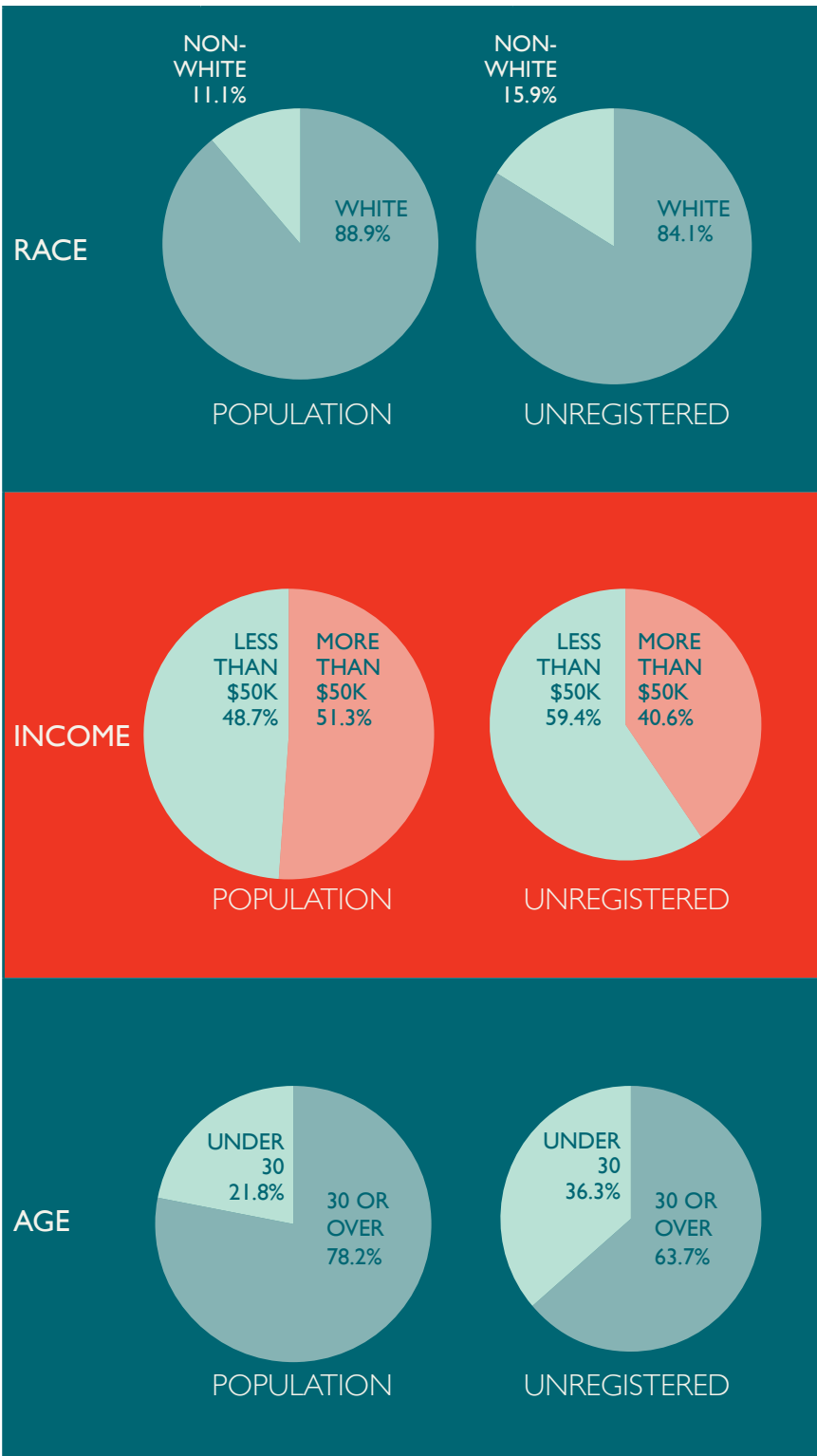

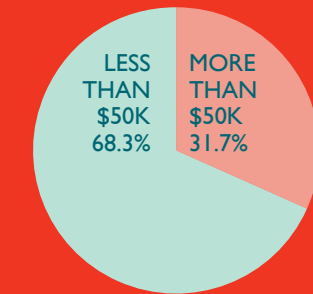

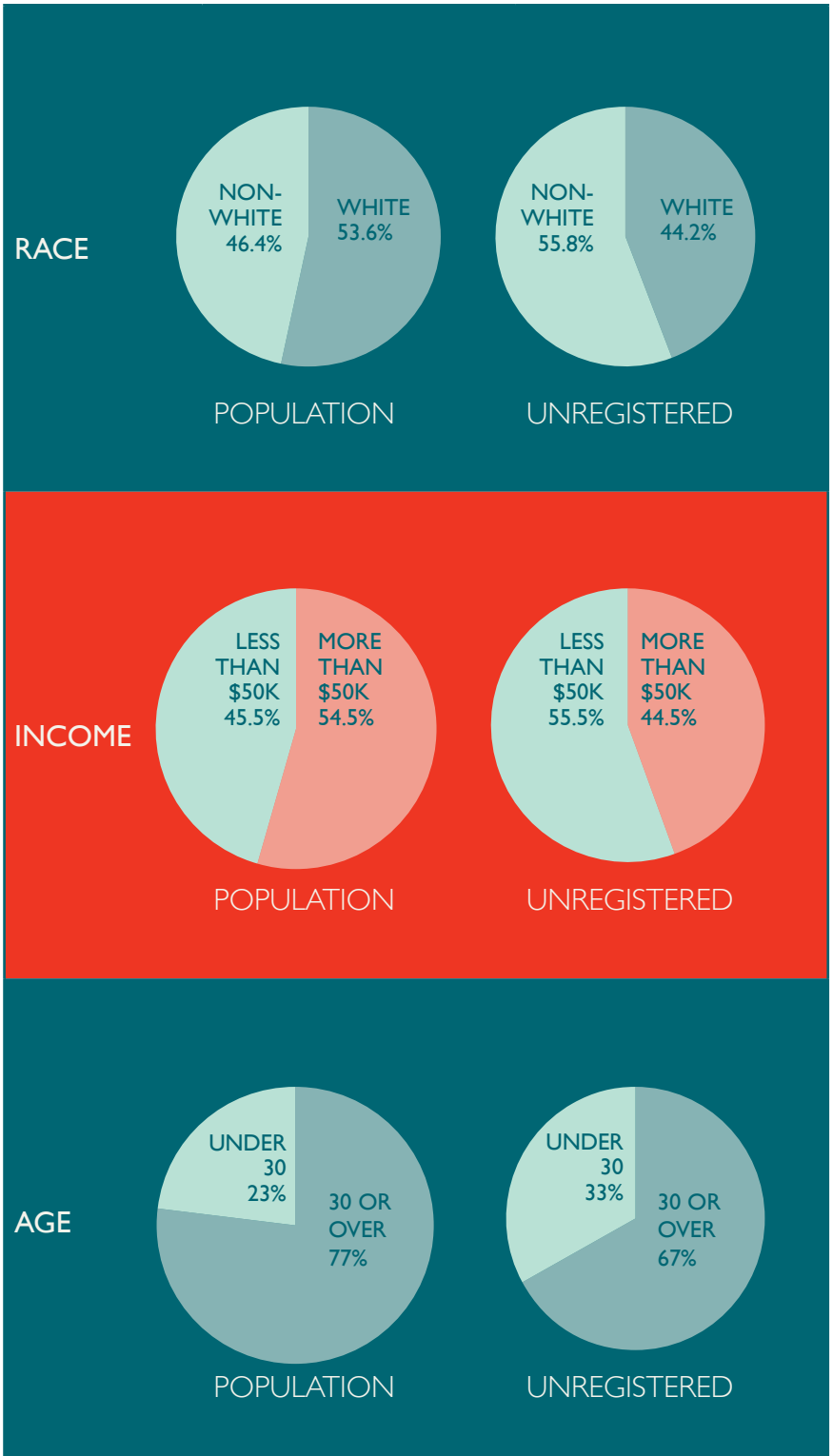

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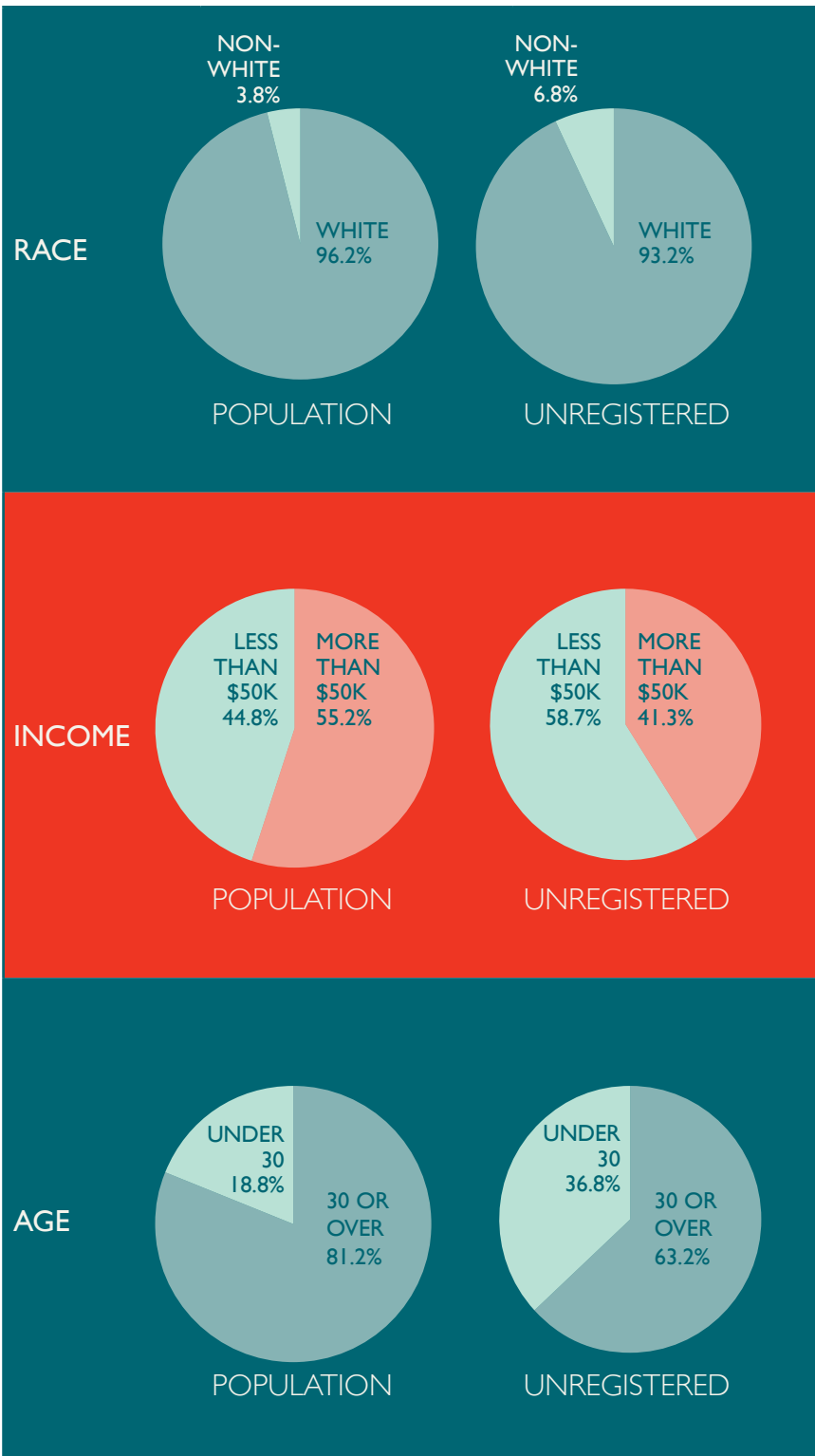

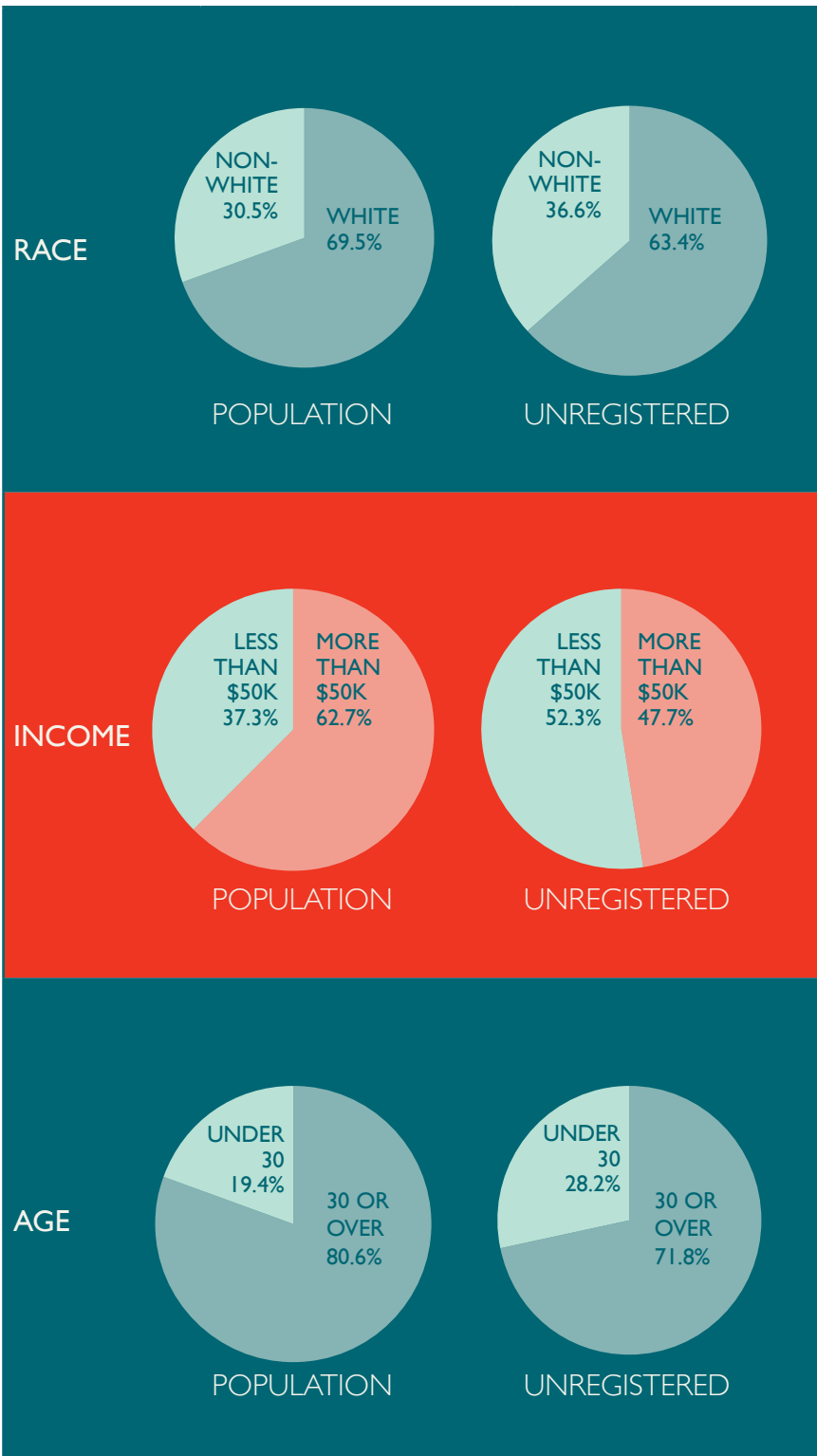

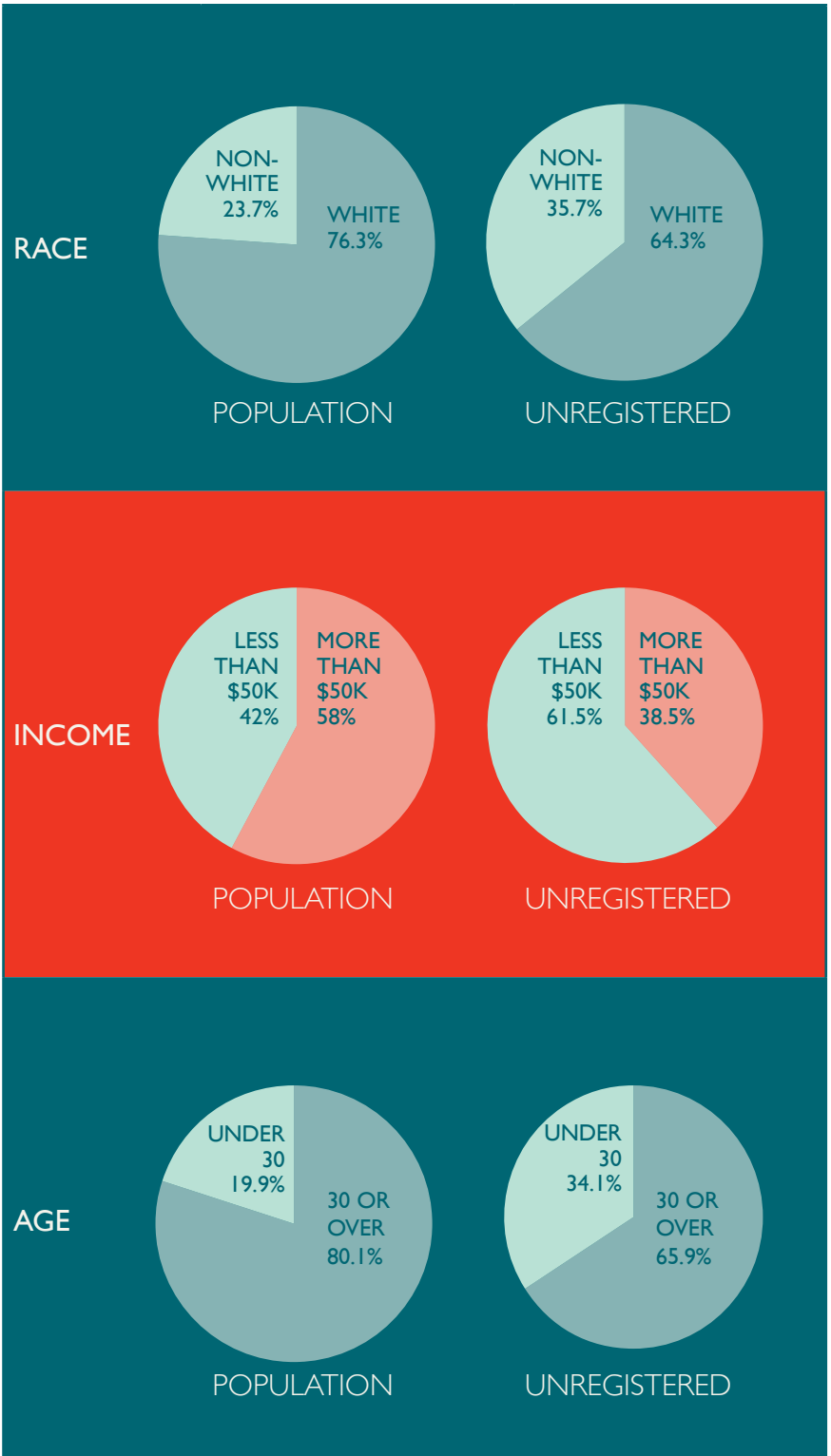

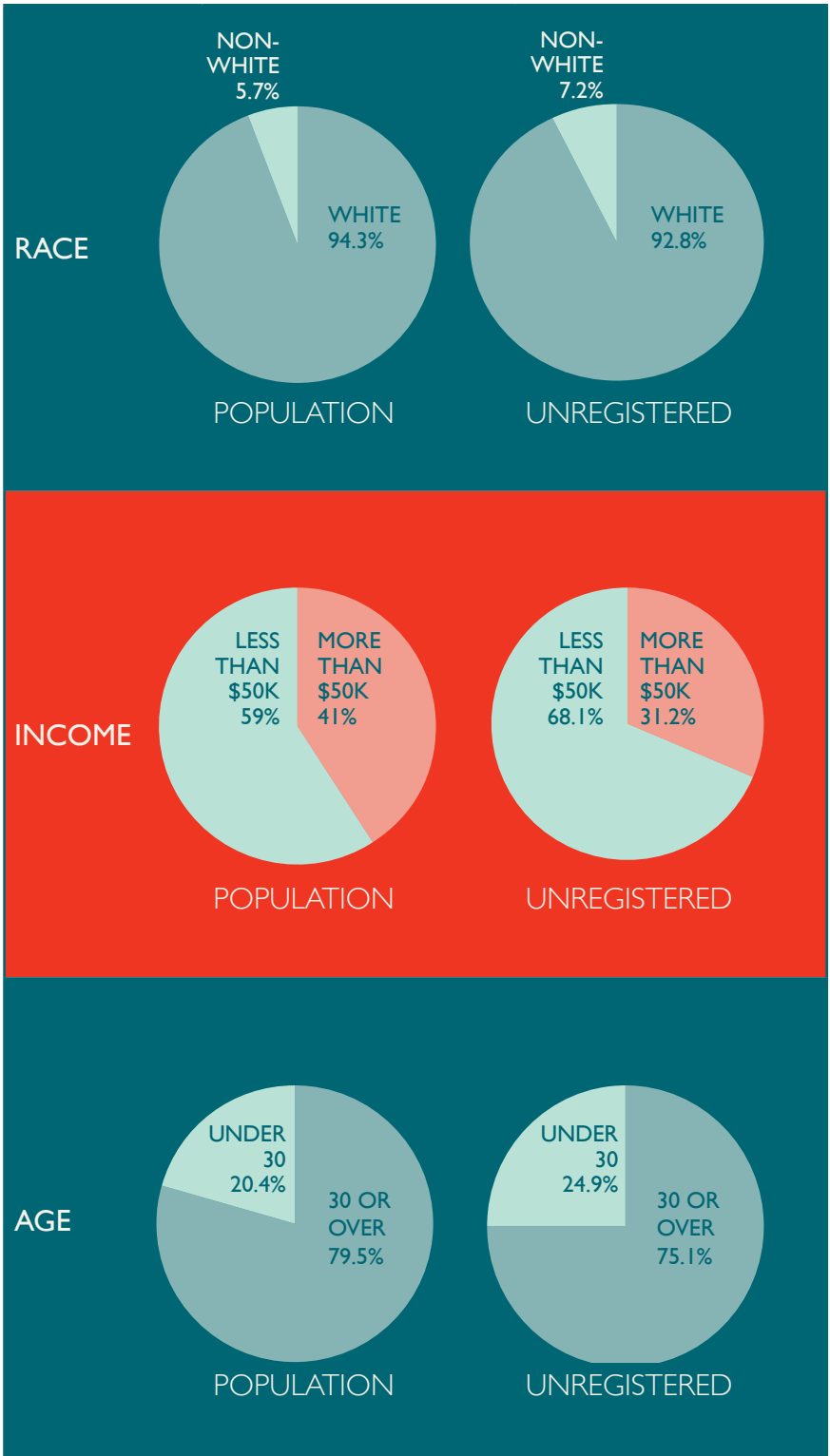

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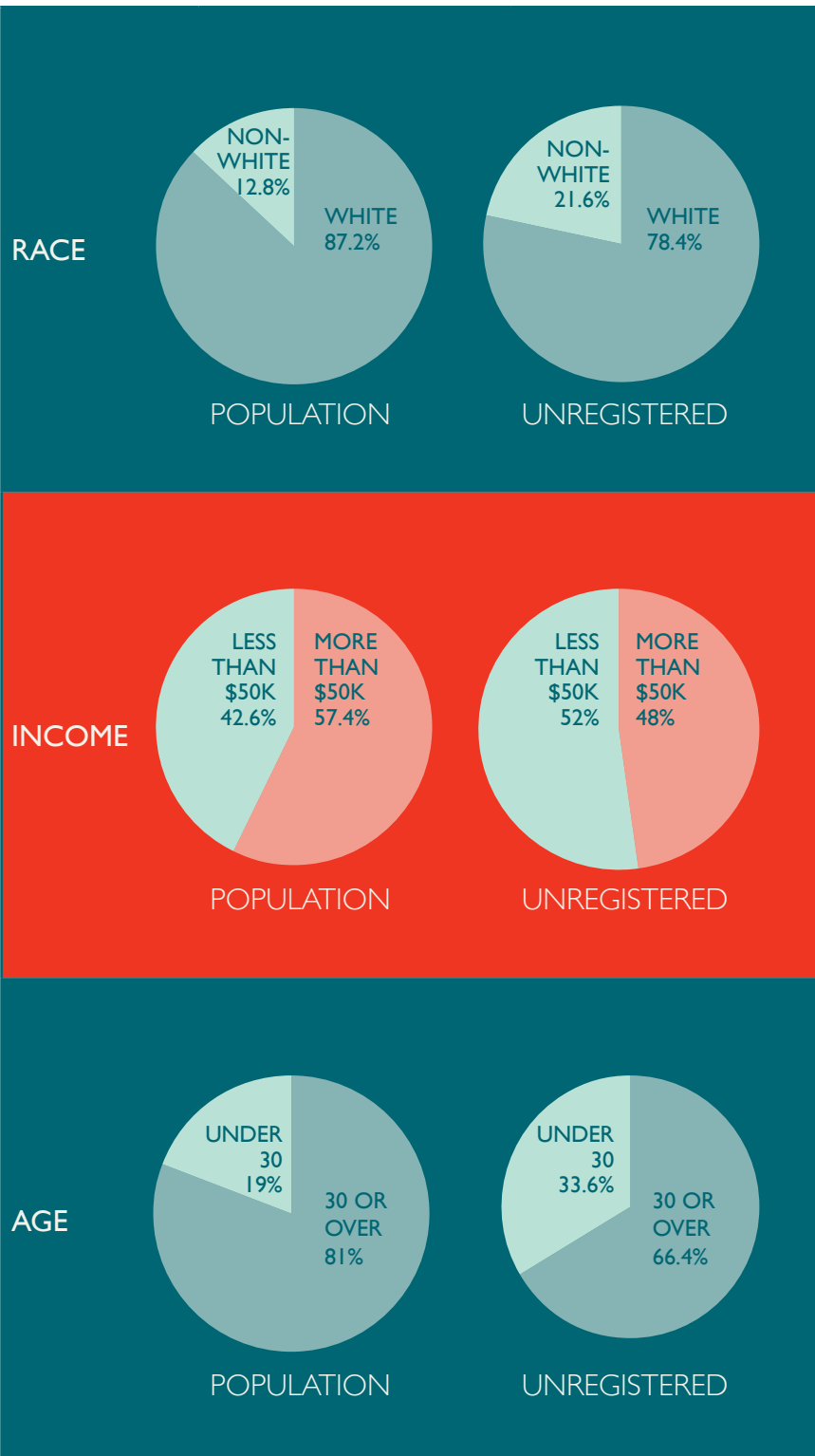

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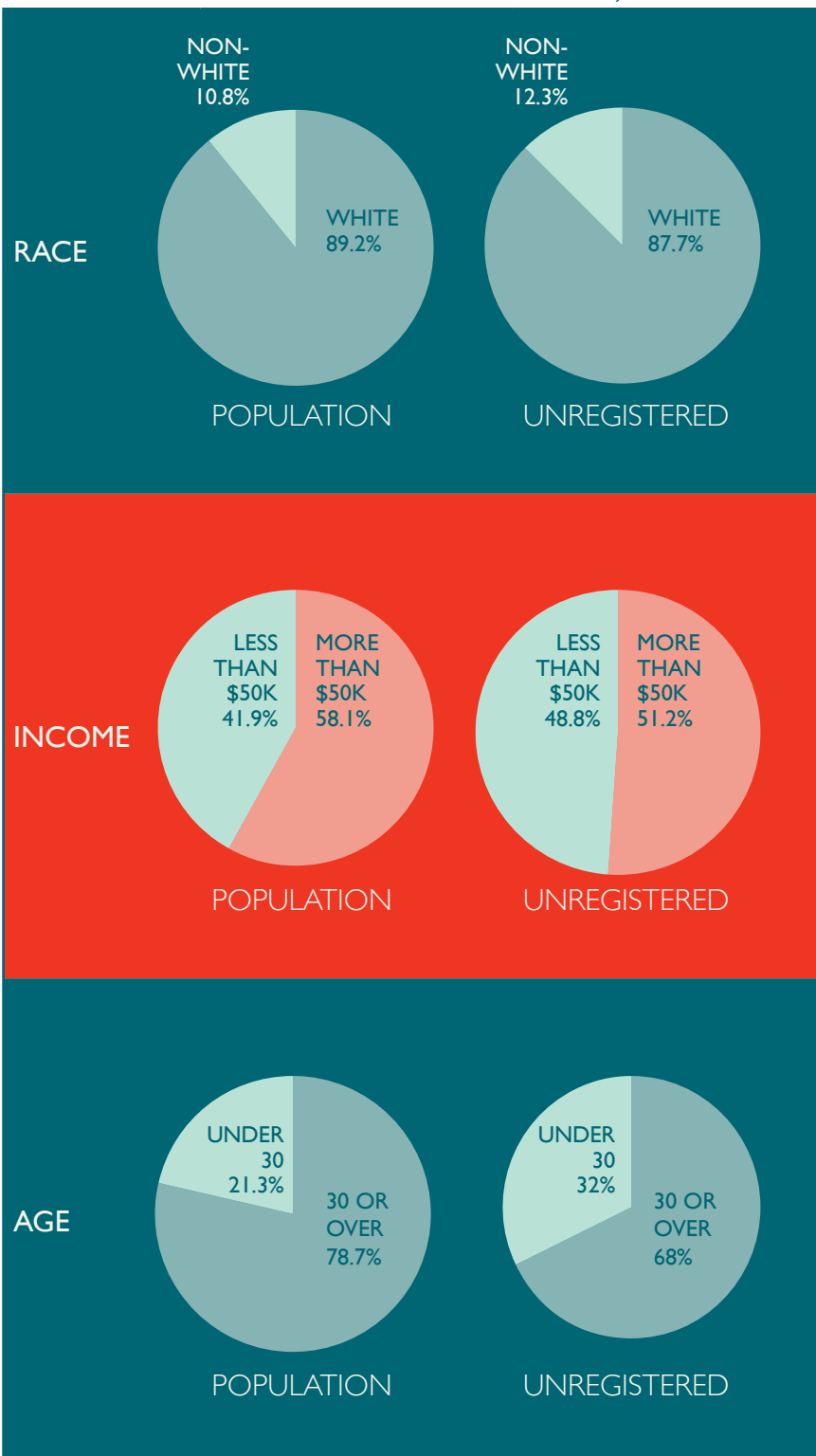
